## **SENATE BILL No. 724**

December 12, 2013, Introduced by Senator HUNE and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 300, entitled
"The public school employees retirement act of 1979,"
by amending sections 69, 69c, 69f, 70, 71, 75, and 76 (MCL 38.1369, 38.1369c, 38.1369f, 38.1370, 38.1371, 38.1375, and 38.1376),
sections 69, 69c, and 70 as amended and section 69f as added by
1989 PA 194, section 71 as amended by 1996 PA 268, section 75 as
amended by 2006 PA 617, and section 76 as added by 1985 PA 91.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 69. (1) As UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, As a condition for granting membership or prior service credit under this act for out of system public education service, a member shall pay MEET BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- (A) PAY to the retirement system an amount equal to the amount the member would have contributed pursuant to the schedule governing member contributions in effect at the time of that

- 1 service had the service been performed under this act or former Act
- 2 No. 136 of the Public Acts of 1945 PA 136, together with regular
- 3 interest from the end of the school fiscal year in which service
- 4 was performed to the semiannual anniversary of the date following
- 5 the payment. , and shall have
- 6 (B) HAVE 5 years of reporting unit service credit under this
- 7 act or former Act No. 136 of the Public Acts of 1945 PA 136,
- 8 following the out of system public education service.
- 9 (2) A-UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, A member shall not be-IS entitled
- 10 to a retirement allowance based on out of system public education
- 11 service that was performed after July 1, 1974, until IF the member
- 12 pays meets both of the following requirements:
- 13 (A) PAYS into the retirement system for that service an amount
- 14 equal to 5% of the member's full-time or equated full-time
- 15 compensation earned in the school fiscal year before the school
- 16 fiscal year in which the application to purchase and payment for
- 17 the service credit is made, multiplied by the years of that service
- 18 the member elects to purchase. and unless that
- 19 (B) THAT service is followed by 5 years of reporting unit
- 20 service credit under this act.
- 21 (3) For the purposes of computing payment under this section,
- 22 the compensation amount used shall not be less than the highest
- 23 school fiscal year compensation previously earned by the member. If
- 24 the compensation amount used for computing payment under this
- 25 section exceeds the member's final average compensation determined
- 26 at the time of retirement, the payment required under this section
- 27 shall be recomputed using the member's final average compensation

- 1 and a refund shall be made based upon the recomputation. Credit
- 2 provided by this section shall not be used in satisfying the
- 3 minimum of 10 years of service credit required under this act for a
- 4 retirement allowance. A person who had employment with a community
- 5 mental health service program as described in section 6(2) shall IS
- 6 not be—subject to the minimum of 10 years of service credit, if the
- 7 other requirements of this section are met.
- 8 (4) A member shall not receive more than 15 years of out of
- 9 system public education service. A member shall not receive more
- 10 out of system public education service than service performed under
- 11 this act or former Act No. 136 of the Public Acts of 1945 PA 136,
- 12 unless, before July 1, 1974, the member applied for out of system
- 13 public education service credit based upon payment of contributions
- 14 for that service credit as required under former Act No. 136 of the
- 15 Public Acts of 1945 PA 136. The total out of system public
- 16 education service credited shall be used to compute the member's
- 17 retirement allowance if the minimum service requirements performed
- 18 under this act or former Act No. 136 of the Public Acts of 1945 PA
- **19 136** are met.
- 20 (5) If a member who made payment for out of system public
- 21 education service dies and a retirement allowance beneficiary has
- 22 not been designated, or if the member withdraws from service before
- 23 his or her retirement becomes effective, the payment made by the
- 24 member UNDER THIS SECTION shall be refunded to the member or to the
- 25 member's refund beneficiary upon request.
- 26 (6) Out of system public education service shall not be
- 27 creditable toward retirement under this act if the member is or

- 1 will be receiving a retirement allowance for the same service from
- 2 another retirement system.
- 3 (7) Out of system public education service shall not be
- 4 creditable under this act unless similar service performed in a
- 5 reporting unit would be creditable.
- 6 (8) Before January 31, 1991, a member may elect to purchase
- 7 service credit as an elementary or secondary teacher at a United
- 8 States armed forces military base in the United States or a foreign
- 9 country upon payment to the retirement board of the actuarial cost.
- 10 (8) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO
- 11 PURCHASE SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- Sec. 69c. (1) A-UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, A member may elect to
- 13 purchase service credit for service performed as an employee in a
- 14 nonpublic elementary or secondary educational institution or a
- 15 nonpublic 2- or 4-year institution of higher education in this
- 16 state, in other states of the United States, or in the territorial
- 17 possessions of the United States upon request and presentation of
- 18 documentation of the employment rendered that is verifiable from
- 19 official employment or payroll records or other acceptable
- 20 documentation as determined by the retirement board, and upon
- 21 payment to the retirement system of the actuarial cost.
- 22 (2) Before January 31, 1991, a member may elect to purchase
- 23 service credit for service performed as an employee in a foreign
- 24 country at a school for United States personnel or dependents of
- 25 the United States military or United States department of state
- 26 personnel; service performed as a full-time teacher with the job
- 27 corps created pursuant to section 422 of part B of title IV of the

- 1 job training partnership act, Public Law 97-300, <del>29 U.S.C. 1692;</del>
- 2 service performed as a teacher in a trust territory or former trust
- 3 territory of the United States; or service performed as a teacher
- 4 on an Indian reservation in this country; upon request and
- 5 presentation of documentation of the employment rendered that is
- 6 verifiable from official employment or payroll records or other
- 7 acceptable documentation as determined by the retirement board, and
- 8 upon payment to the retirement system of the actuarial cost.
- 9 (3) Service shall not be credited under this section unless
- 10 the service being purchased is followed by at least 5 years of
- 11 reporting unit service credit under this act or former Act No. 136
- 12 of the Public Acts of 1945 PA 136. Service purchased under this
- 13 section shall not be used to satisfy the minimum of 10 years of
- 14 service credit required to receive a retirement allowance under
- 15 this act. The total service credited under subsections (1) and (2)
- 16 shall not exceed 5 years.
- 17 (4) If a member who made payment for service under this
- 18 section dies and a retirement allowance beneficiary has not been
- 19 designated, or if the member withdraws from service before his or
- 20 her retirement becomes effective, the payment made by the member
- 21 shall be refunded to the member or to the member's refund
- 22 beneficiary upon request.
- 23 (5) Service shall not be credited under this section if the
- 24 member is or will be receiving a pension or annuity for the same
- 25 service from another retirement system.
- 26 (6) A person who became a retirant with a retirement allowance
- 27 effective date on or after January 1, 1988 and on or before

- 1 December 21, 1988 shall be entitled to purchase service credit for
- 2 service performed as an employee in a nonpublic elementary or
- 3 secondary educational institution or a nonpublic 2- or 4-year
- 4 institution of higher education as provided by this section.
- 5 Service credit purchased pursuant to this subsection shall be
- 6 purchased before July 1, 1989, or the expiration of 6 months after
- 7 December 21, 1988, whichever is later. The monthly retirement
- 8 allowance of a retirant entitled to purchase service credit under
- 9 this subsection shall be recomputed based upon the additional
- 10 service credit. The recomputed monthly amount shall be payable
- 11 beginning on the first day of the month following the month in
- 12 which payment is received by the retirement system.
- 13 (6) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO
- 14 PURCHASE SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 15 (7) As used in this section:
- 16 (a) "Nonpublic elementary or secondary educational
- 17 institution" means an institution that offers or provides an
- 18 organized course of academic study primarily oriented toward the
- 19 awarding of high school diplomas. Nonpublic elementary or secondary
- 20 educational institution does not include a proprietary school.
- 21 (b) "Nonpublic 2- or 4-year institution of higher education"
- 22 means an institution that offers an organized course of academic
- 23 study primarily oriented toward the awarding of associate,
- 24 baccalaureate, master's, doctoral, or other academic degrees.
- 25 Nonpublic 2- or 4-year institution of higher education does not
- 26 include a proprietary school.
- (c) "Proprietary school" means a school that uses a certain

- 1 plan or method to teach a trade, occupation, or vocation for a
- 2 consideration, reward, or promise. Proprietary school includes, but
- 3 is not limited to, a private business, trade, or home study school.
- 4 Sec. 69f. (1) A-UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, A member may elect to
- 5 purchase not more than 5 years of service credit less the number of
- 6 years of service credit purchased under sections 6(2)(c), (d), (e),
- 7 and (f), 64(3), (4), and (5), 69a, 69b, AND 69c(2), 69d, 69e, 74a,
- 8 74b, 77, and 78, OR FORMER SECTIONS 69A, 69B, 69D, 69E, 74A, 74B,
- 9 77, AND 78, upon request and payment to the retirement system of
- 10 the actuarial cost.
- 11 (2) Service credit purchased under this section may—SHALL not
- 12 be used to satisfy the minimum of 10 years of service credit
- 13 required to receive a retirement allowance under this act.
- 14 (3) Service credit purchased under this section shall not be
- 15 used to satisfy the service credit requirement set forth DESCRIBED
- 16 in section 81(1)(a) for a retirement allowance paid prior to BEFORE
- 17 age 46 as provided by section 43b(a).
- 18 (4) If a member who made payment for service under this
- 19 section dies and a retirement allowance is not payable, or if the
- 20 member withdraws from service and a retirement allowance is not
- 21 payable, the payment made by the member shall be refunded to the
- 22 member or to the member's refund beneficiary upon request.
- 23 (5) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO
- 24 PURCHASE SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 25 Sec. 70. (1) As UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, AS a condition for
- 26 granting membership or prior service credit under this act for
- 27 state of Michigan service, a member shall pay MEET BOTH OF THE

## 1 FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- 2 (A) PAY to the retirement system an amount equal to the amount
- 3 the member would have contributed under the contributory plan for
- 4 service performed before July 1, 1977 pursuant to the schedule
- 5 governing member contributions in effect at the time of that
- 6 service had the service been performed under this act or former Act
- 7 No. 136 of the Public Acts of 1945 PA 136, together with regular
- 8 interest from the end of the school fiscal year in which the
- 9 service was performed to the semiannual anniversary of the date
- 10 following payment. , and shall relinquish
- 11 (B) RELINQUISH all rights to retirement under the state
- 12 employees' retirement act, Act No. 240 of the Public Acts of 1943,
- as amended, being sections 38.1 to 38.47 of the Michigan Compiled
- 14 Laws. A 1943 PA 240, MCL 38.1 TO 38.69. UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, A
- 15 member shall not—IS ENTITLED TO receive benefits pursuant to—UNDER
- 16 sections 43b and 43c for service performed on or after January 1,
- 17 1987 until—IF the member pays the difference between the actuarial
- 18 equivalent of the benefits provided by sections 43b and 43c and by
- 19 the state employees' retirement act, Act No. 240 of the Public Acts
- 20 of 1943.1943 PA 240, MCL 38.1 TO 38.69.
- 21 (2) Credit for service performed as a state employee under the
- 22 state employees' retirement act, Act No. 240 of the Public Acts of
- 23 1943, as amended, 1943 PA 240, MCL 38.1 TO 38.69, shall be on the
- 24 same basis for eligibility in all respects, for any form of
- 25 retirement provided in this act as if the service were performed in
- 26 a reporting unit under this act.
- 27 (3) A-UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, A former member who on or before

- 1 July 1, 1974, was employed in the state classified or unclassified
- 2 service, whose membership was transferred to the state employees'
- 3 retirement system under the state employees' retirement act, Act
- 4 No. 240 of the Public Acts of 1943, as amended, 1943 PA 240, MCL
- 5 38.1 TO 38.69, and who again became a member of the retirement
- 6 system created under former Act No. 136 of the Public Acts of 1945
- 7 PA 136 or becomes a member of the retirement system created under
- 8 this act, shall be IS entitled to petition the retirement system in
- 9 writing for a transfer of the member's accumulated contributions,
- 10 including interest, and service standing to the member's credit
- 11 with the state employees' retirement system to this retirement
- 12 system. Upon receipt of the member's petition, service standing to
- 13 the member's credit, accumulated contributions, and interest shall

- 2 (5) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO
- 3 PURCHASE SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 4 Sec. 71. (1) The UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, THE retirement board
- 5 shall grant service credit for the time a member is on a sabbatical
- 6 leave authorized by a reporting unit, if the member returns to
- 7 regular employment with the same reporting unit and acquires 1 year
- 8 or more of subsequent service credit with that same reporting unit
- 9 and if the member acquired 5 or more years of credited service with
- 10 the reporting unit immediately before the sabbatical leave.
- 11 (2) If the sabbatical leave described in subsection (1) is
- 12 granted before July 1, 1981, the reporting unit, if the reporting
- 13 unit had a noncontributory plan at the time the sabbatical leave is
- 14 granted, or the member, if the reporting unit has a contributory
- 15 plan at the time the sabbatical leave is granted, shall pay to the
- 16 system for each year of sabbatical leave credit an amount equal to
- 17 5% of the member's compensation earned in the school fiscal year
- 18 immediately before the school fiscal year in which the sabbatical

In computing payment under 7 this subsection, the compensation amount used, except as otherwise 8 provided in this subsection, shall not be less than the highest 9 10 school fiscal year compensation the member earned from the 11 reporting unit that granted the sabbatical leave. If a member has paid the 24 amount required under subsection (2) for the purchase of service 25 credit for sabbatical leave, but later receives a refund of that 26 amount, the member, not the reporting unit, shall repay the amount 27 with regular interest as required by subsection (2) if the member

- 2 (3) (5) Effective October 1, 1981, UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, the
- 3 retirement board shall grant service credit for the time a member
- 4 is on either an employee organization professional services leave
- 5 or employee organization professional services released time
- 6 authorized by a reporting unit if all of the following conditions
- 7 are satisfied, as applicable:
- 8 (a) For a member who is on either a professional services
- 9 leave or professional services released time that first began
- 10 before October 1, 1996, which leave or released time is renewed
- 11 annually by the reporting unit, the member is included on the
- 12 reporting unit's reports required by section 42(6) and
- 13 compensation, service, contribution, and other requirements are
- 14 reported on the same basis as for those members of the reporting
- 15 unit who were not granted an employee organization professional
- 16 services leave or employee organization professional services
- 17 released time.
- 18 (b) For a member who is on either a professional services
- 19 leave or professional services released time, which leave or
- 20 released time does not meet the requirements of subdivision (a),
- 21 the member is included on the reporting unit's reports in the
- 22 manner required by subdivision (a), except that compensation is
- 23 reported at the rate of compensation paid to the member by the
- 24 reporting unit immediately preceding the date the member commenced
- 25 the professional services leave or professional services released
- 26 time along with the normal and customary compensation increases
- 27 that would have been paid to the member by the reporting unit had

- 1 the member remained in the same position held at the reporting unit
- 2 immediately preceding the date the member commenced the leave or
- 3 released time. However, if the member was not working a full 12-
- 4 month period for the reporting unit immediately preceding the date
- 5 the member commenced the professional services leave or
- 6 professional services released time and is working a full 12-month
- 7 period for the public school employee organization, the rate of
- 8 compensation paid to the member by the reporting unit immediately
- 9 preceding the date the member commenced the leave or released time
- 10 may be increased proportionately to reflect the additional time
- 11 worked for the public school employee organization. That adjusted
- 12 compensation, along with the normal and customary compensation
- increases otherwise allowed in this subdivision, shall then be
- 14 reported as required in this subdivision.
- (c) For a member who is on either a professional services
- 16 leave or professional services released time that first began
- 17 before October 1, 1996, which leave or released time is renewed
- 18 annually by the reporting unit, the reporting unit remits the
- 19 amount required by section 42 and the percentage of aggregate
- 20 annual compensation provided from the state school aid fund for
- 21 current service, if any, the percentage determined for unfunded
- 22 accrued service as required by section 41, and the employer's share
- 23 of social security contributions if the reporting unit is
- 24 responsible for remitting the employee's share of social security
- 25 contributions.
- 26 (d) For a member who is on either a professional services
- 27 leave or professional services released time, which professional

- 1 services leave or professional services released time does not meet
- 2 the requirements of subdivision (c), the reporting unit remits the
- 3 amounts required by subdivision (c) based upon the rate of
- 4 compensation paid to the member by the reporting unit immediately
- 5 preceding the date the member commenced the professional services
- 6 leave or professional services released time along with the normal
- 7 and customary compensation increases that would have been paid to
- 8 the member by the reporting unit had the member remained in the
- 9 same position held at the reporting unit immediately preceding the
- 10 date the member commenced the leave or released time. However, if
- 11 the member was not working a full 12-month period for the reporting
- 12 unit immediately preceding the date the member commenced the
- 13 professional services leave or professional services released time
- 14 and is working a full 12-month period for the public school
- 15 employee organization, the rate of compensation paid to the member
- 16 by the reporting unit immediately preceding the date the member
- 17 commenced the leave or released time may be increased
- 18 proportionately to reflect the additional time worked for the
- 19 public school employee organization. That adjusted compensation,
- 20 along with the normal and customary compensation increases
- 21 otherwise allowed in this subdivision, shall then be reported as
- 22 required in this subdivision.
- 23 (4) (6)—The reporting unit shall be reimbursed those sums paid
- 24 to the retirement board pursuant to UNDER subsection (5) (3) by the
- 25 member or the public school employee organization on a current
- 26 basis. A member who has credited service as an employee of a school
- 27 district of the first class, as described in part 6 of the revised

- 1 school code, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, being sections
- 2 380.401 to 380.485 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, 1976 PA 451, MCL
- 3 380.401 TO 380.485, for a leave of absence effective before October
- 4 1, 1981, shall continue to receive credit based upon the provisions
- 5 of the law of this state in effect at the time the leave of absence
- 6 was initially effective.
- 7 (5) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO
- 8 PURCHASE SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 9 Sec. 75. (1) A-UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, A member who left or
- 10 leaves service as a public school employee; who left or leaves out-
- 11 of-system public education service; or a member of the state
- 12 employees' retirement system under section 13 of the state
- 13 employees' retirement act, 1943 PA 240, MCL 38.13, who left or
- 14 leaves service as a state employee for purposes of parental leave
- 15 who subsequently becomes a member of this retirement system without
- 16 other intervening employment of more than 20 hours per week for
- 17 each week for which service credit was claimed may purchase service
- 18 credit for the time period or periods during which the person was
- 19 separated from service because of parental leave if the member
- 20 satisfies the requirements of this section. The member shall submit
- 21 an application as described in subsection (5) and shall pay the
- 22 actuarial cost to the retirement system. The total service credited
- 23 under this section shall not exceed 5 years. A member requesting
- 24 purchase of service credit under this section shall certify to the
- 25 retirement system the purpose for which the member took leave or
- 26 was separated from service as a public school employee; a person
- 27 performing out-of-system public education service; or a member of

- 1 the state employees' retirement system under section 13 of the
- 2 state employees' retirement act, 1943 PA 240, MCL 38.13.
- 3 (2) Service credit purchased under this section may not be
- 4 used to satisfy the minimum of 10 years of service credit required
- 5 to receive a retirement allowance under this act.
- 6 (3) If a member who made payment under this section dies and a
- 7 retirement allowance beneficiary has not been designated, or if the
- 8 member leaves reporting unit service before his or her retirement
- 9 becomes effective, the payment made by the member shall be refunded
- 10 upon request to the member or to the member's refund beneficiary.
- 11 (4) A member who reduces hours of employment with a reporting
- 12 unit for purposes of parental leave or a person who reduces hours
- 13 of out of system public education service for purposes of parental
- 14 leave and who subsequently becomes a member of this retirement
- 15 system may purchase service credit for those hours by which
- 16 employment was reduced if all other requirements of this section
- 17 are met.
- 18 (5) A member requesting purchase of service credit under this
- 19 section shall submit an application as prescribed by the retirement
- 20 system in which the member shall certify the time period claimed
- 21 for parental leave and the purpose of the parental leave. If the
- 22 request for purchase of service credit under this section is a
- 23 result of leave taken to care for the member's child by birth or
- 24 adoption, then the member also shall submit a certified copy of a
- 25 birth certificate or adoption document from the appropriate court
- 26 of jurisdiction.
- 27 (6) Parental leave is creditable under this act until the

- 1 child, by birth or adoption, attains age 18 or is married,
- 2 whichever occurs first.
- 3 (7) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO
- 4 PURCHASE SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 5 (8) (7) As used in this section, "parental leave" means either
- 6 of the following:
- 7 (a) The presence of the member in the active participation or
- 8 supervision in the day-to-day, ongoing care or maintenance of his
- 9 or her child by birth or adoption, for which the member reduced or
- 10 eliminated the number of hours worked for the state, in out-of-
- 11 system public education service, or for the reporting unit in a
- 12 normal work time period.
- 13 (b) A member's pregnancy that occurred while a member, whether
- 14 brought to full term or not, childbirth, and recuperation, for
- 15 which the member reduced or eliminated the number of hours worked
- 16 for the state, in out-of-system public education service, or for
- 17 the reporting unit in a normal work time period.
- 18 Sec. 76. (1) On and after the effective date of this section,
- 19 UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014, a member who is otherwise entitled to purchase
- 20 service credit for active duty in the armed forces under section 73
- 21 or 74, or for maternity or paternity or child rearing under section
