THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2978. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) WHO,
- 2 IN THE COURSE OF THE PRACTICE OF HIS OR HER PROFESSION OR HIS OR
- 3 HER EMPLOYMENT, HAS REASONABLE CAUSE TO SUSPECT HUMAN TRAFFICKING
- 4 AND WHO IN GOOD FAITH REPORTS THE SUSPECTED HUMAN TRAFFICKING TO A
- 5 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR COOPERATES IN AN INVESTIGATION OF THE
- 6 SUSPECTED HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR THE
- 7 REPORTING OR COOPERATION.
 - (2) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 27 THAT IS A VIOLATION OF CHAPTER LXVIIA OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE,
