## **SENATE BILL No. 870**

March 12, 2014, Introduced by Senator SCHUITMAKER and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Elections.

A bill to regulate local ordinances controlling the placement, appearance, or operation of bins for the collection of certain reusable or recyclable materials; to provide for fees; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and local units of government; and to provide for civil sanctions and remedies.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
  "textile recycling bin act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
  - (a) "Charitable organization" means an organization that is exempt from taxation pursuant to section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code, 26 USC 501(c)(3).

- 1 (b) "Local unit of government" or "local unit" means a county,
- 2 city, village, or township.
- 3 (c) "Permittee" means a person that receives a permit to
- 4 operate a textile recycling bin pursuant to this act.
- 5 (d) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 6 association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.
- 7 (e) "Person in lawful possession of the property" means a
- 8 person that leases property from the property owner, or a person
- 9 that represents the lessee and has authority from the lessee over
- 10 the property, such as a store manager, regional manager, or
- 11 superintendent.
- 12 (f) "Place a textile recycling bin" or "place a bin" means to
- 13 put the bin in a location where it is intended to be operated for
- 14 solicitation purposes.
- 15 (g) "Professional fund-raiser" means that term as defined in
- 16 section 2 of the charitable organizations and solicitations act,
- 17 1975 PA 169, MCL 400.272.
- 18 (h) "Property owner" means the person having legal title to
- 19 property.
- 20 (i) "Property owner's agent" means a person that has express
- 21 oral or written authority or implied authority through employment
- 22 or by contract or who has apparent authority to enter a contract on
- 23 behalf of the property owner.
- 24 (j) "Solicitation" means solicitation of donations of
- 25 salvageable personal property or household items for the purpose of
- 26 reuse or recycling.
- (k) "Textile recycling bin" or "bin" means an unattended,

- 1 closed receptacle or container made of metal, wood, or plastic or a
- 2 combination thereof and designed and intended for the collection
- 3 from the public of donations of used clothing, shoes, textiles,
- 4 household items, books, magazines, other salvageable personal
- 5 property, or wastepaper, for the purpose of reuse or recycling.
- 6 Textile recycling bin does not include a receptacle or container
- 7 used to collect recyclable metal, plastic, or glass or a household
- 8 curbside recycling container or other container used to receive
- 9 recyclables from a specific person or persons.
- 10 Sec. 5. (1) Except as provided in this act, a local unit of
- 11 government shall not enact or enforce an ordinance prohibiting or
- 12 regulating the placement, appearance, or operation of textile
- 13 recycling bins located outdoors.
- 14 (2) This act does not prohibit a local unit of government from
- 15 adopting or enforcing a zoning ordinance that does any of the
- 16 following:
- 17 (a) Prohibiting bins in certain zoning districts, subject to
- 18 section 207 of the Michigan zoning enabling act, 2006 PA 110, MCL
- **19** 125.2307.
- 20 (b) Limiting the number of bins that may be placed on a lot or
- 21 parcel.
- (c) Requiring bins to be set back specified distances from
- 23 structures such as roads, driveways, sidewalks, buildings, utility
- 24 poles, or traffic signs.
- Sec. 7. (1) A local unit of government may adopt an ordinance
- 26 prohibiting a person from placing or operating a textile recycling
- 27 bin outdoors unless the person obtains a permit from the local unit

- 1 as provided under this section.
- 2 (2) To obtain a permit under an ordinance adopted under
- 3 subsection (1), a person shall file an application with the local
- 4 unit of government. A separate permit is required for each bin.
- 5 However, a single application may seek permits for up to 10 textile
- 6 recycling bins. There is no limit on the number of bins for which
- 7 applications may be filed and permits may be issued.
- 8 (3) A permit application under subsection (2) shall include
- 9 all of the following:
- (a) The applicant's name, address, telephone number,
- 11 electronic mail address, website address, if any, and fax number,
- 12 if any. The information provided under this subdivision shall be
- 13 for the applicant's registered office under section 241 of the
- 14 business corporation act, 1972 PA 284, MCL 450.1241, or section 241
- of the nonprofit corporation act, 1982 PA 162, MCL 450.2241, if the
- 16 applicant is incorporated under 1 of those acts.
- 17 (b) The name and contact information of the applicant's
- 18 resident agent under section 241 of the business corporation act,
- 19 1972 PA 284, MCL 450.1241, or section 241 of the nonprofit
- 20 corporation act, 1982 PA 162, MCL 450.2241, if the applicant is
- 21 incorporated under 1 of those acts.
- 22 (c) A certificate of good standing with this state under
- 23 section 922 of the business corporation act, 1972 PA 284, MCL
- 24 450.1922, or section 922 of the nonprofit corporation act, 1982 PA
- 25 162, MCL 450.2922, issued within the past 90 days, if the applicant
- 26 is incorporated under 1 of those acts.
- 27 (d) The manner in which any clothing or other donations

- 1 collected are expected to be used, sold, or distributed.
- 2 (e) The name and telephone number of any entity that will
- 3 receive some or all of the donations collected in the textile
- 4 recycling bins or the proceeds thereof, if the applicant is a for-
- 5 profit business.
- 6 (f) The address and, as precisely as possible, location where
- 7 each bin will be placed, and the name of any business at the
- 8 location.
- 9 (g) Written consent from the property owner, property owner's
- 10 agent, or person in lawful possession of the property to place the
- 11 bin on the property identified in subdivision (f). This subdivision
- 12 does not apply if the applicant is the property owner, property
- 13 owner's agent, or person in lawful possession of the property.
- 14 (4) A local unit of government shall not grant an application
- 15 for a permit to place and operate a textile recycling bin if the
- 16 application is not complete or if the local unit determines that
- 17 the operation, display, or placement of the bin will violate any
- 18 state law or any ordinance provision described in section 5(2).
- 19 (5) A local unit of government may impose a fee for processing
- 20 an application for a permit. The fee shall not exceed the lesser of
- 21 the following:
- 22 (a) \$75.00, regardless of the number of textile recycling bins
- 23 covered by the application.
- 24 (b) The actual reasonable costs of processing an application.
- 25 (6) A permit under this section is valid for 1 year.
- 26 (7) A local unit of government shall provide a permittee with
- 27 1 permit sticker for each approved permit. The sticker shall

- 1 display the local unit's seal, a permit number, and an expiration
- 2 date. The size of the sticker shall be 4 inches by 4 inches. The
- 3 color of the sticker shall be the same color that the department of
- 4 state uses for motor vehicle registration decals for that year. The
- 5 permittee shall place the sticker in a conspicuous place on the
- 6 front panel of the textile recycling bin. On request of the
- 7 permittee, the local unit shall provide a replacement sticker for a
- 8 fee of \$10.00 if the original sticker is damaged or lost.
- 9 (8) An expiring permit for a textile recycling bin may be
- 10 renewed. Subsection (2) and subsections (4) to (7) apply to the
- 11 renewal application and permit. The application for a renewal
- 12 permit shall include all of the following:
- 13 (a) The permit number.
- 14 (b) The information required under subsection (3)(f).
- 15 (c) Any change in the information required under subsection
- **16** (3) (a) or (b).
- 17 Sec. 9. A local unit of government may adopt an ordinance
- 18 prohibiting a person from placing or operating a textile recycling
- 19 bin outdoors unless the person does all of the following:
- 20 (a) Provides proof to the clerk of the local unit of
- 21 government of a certificate of liability insurance of at least
- 22 \$1,000,000.00 for all permitted bins.
- 23 (b) Maintains the appearance of the bin, including fresh
- 24 paint, readable signage, and general upkeep.
- 25 (c) Maintains a telephone number to receive complaints about
- 26 the bin that is answered live during the hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- 27 (d) Provides the property owner, property owner's agent, or

- 1 person in lawful possession of the property with the telephone
- 2 number under subdivision (c).
- 3 (e) Removes graffiti and trash from the bin and trash from
- 4 outside the bin within a reasonable time after receiving
- 5 notification of its presence.
- 6 (f) Repairs, replaces, or removes a damaged bin within 5
- 7 business days after receiving notification of its condition or
- 8 within a reasonable amount of time, whichever is less.
- 9 (g) Ensures that the front of the bin conspicuously displays
- 10 all of the following:
- 11 (i) The person's name, address, telephone number under
- 12 subdivision (c), and website address, if any.
- (ii) A statement, in at least 2-inch type, that reads either
- 14 "This recycling bin is owned and operated by a nonprofit
- 15 organization." or "This recycling bin is owned and operated by a
- 16 for-profit business.", as applicable.
- 17 (iii) If the bin is owned by a nonprofit organization, the front
- 18 of the bin shall also conspicuously display a statement describing
- 19 the charitable cause that will benefit from donations.
- 20 (iv) If the bin is owned by a for-profit business, the front of
- 21 the bin shall conspicuously display a statement that reads "A
- 22 donation to this bin is not tax deductible.".
- 23 (v) If the bin is owned and operated by a professional fund-
- 24 raiser, the professional fund-raiser shall not post notice of
- 25 donations to a charitable organization except on the sides of the
- 26 bin. Such a notice shall not contain larger type size or cover an
- 27 area larger than the professional fund-raiser's name and address

- 1 that is posted on the front of the recycling bin. The notice shall
- 2 not constitute more than 25% of the total space occupied by
- 3 information on the bin required under this act.
- 4 Sec. 11. (1) A textile recycling bin that is in violation of
- 5 an ordinance adopted under this act is a public nuisance. The
- 6 attorney for the local unit of government may bring an action to
- 7 abate the nuisance.
- 8 (2) A person who violates an ordinance adopted under this act
- 9 is responsible for a municipal civil infraction and may be ordered
- 10 to pay a civil fine of not more than \$500.00 per textile recycling
- 11 bin in violation of the ordinance.
- 12 (3) A person who perpetrates a fraud regarding the operation
- 13 or use of a textile recycling bin is responsible for a municipal
- 14 civil infraction and shall be ordered to pay a civil fine of not
- 15 less than \$500.00 or more than \$1,000.00 per recycling bin. In
- 16 addition, the court shall do both of the following:
- 17 (a) Authorize the local unit of government at its discretion
- 18 to revoke all permits issued to the defendant by the local unit
- 19 under section 7.
- 20 (b) Authorize the local unit at its discretion to remove all
- 21 bins placed by the defendant and store the bins in a secure
- 22 location until the bins are retrieved by the defendant. The bins
- 23 shall be released to the defendant upon payment of all reasonable
- 24 costs incurred by the local unit for removal and storage.
- 25 (4) A violation of an ordinance adopted under this act may be
- 26 prosecuted by the prosecutor for the local unit of government where
- 27 the violation occurred. A fine collected for a violation of this

- ${f 1}$  act shall be deposited in the general fund of the local unit of
- 2 government.
