A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 145E. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (A) POST ON THE INTERNET ANY SEXUALLY EXPLICIT PHOTOGRAPH,
- 3 DRAWING, OR OTHER VISUAL IMAGE OF ANOTHER PERSON WITH THE INTENT TO
 - FRIGHTEN, INTIMIDATE, OR HARASS ANY PERSON.
- 5 (B) HAVING POSTED ON THE INTERNET ANY SEXUALLY EXPLICIT
 - PHOTOGRAPH, DRAWING, OR OTHER VISUAL IMAGE OF ANOTHER PERSON,
 - REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE POSTING WAS WITH THE INTENT TO FRIGHTEN,
- INTIMIDATE, OR HARASS ANY PERSON, REFUSE OR OTHERWISE FAIL TO

- 1 REMOVE THAT EXPLICIT PHOTOGRAPH, DRAWING, OR OTHER VISUAL IMAGE

- 16 DISPLAYING A PERSON'S GENITALIA OR ANUS OR, IF THE PERSON IS A
- 17 FEMALE, HER NIPPLES OR AREOLA.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless Senate Bill No. 925
- of the 97th Legislature is enacted into law.
