## **SENATE BILL No. 977**

June 11, 2014, Introduced by Senators MOOLENAAR, EMMONS, BOOHER, GREEN, MEEKHOF, HILDENBRAND, PAVLOV, MARLEAU, JONES, ROBERTSON, COLBECK, HUNE and PAPPAGEORGE and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms and electro-muscular disruption devices under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5l (MCL 28.425l), as amended by 2012 PA 32.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 5l. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol issued on or after July 1, 2003 but before July 1, 2006 is valid for 5 years.

(2) An initial A license to carry a concealed pistol, issued or renewed on or after July 1, 2006, other than a license described

- 1 in subsection (1), INCLUDING A RENEWAL LICENSE, is valid until the
- 2 applicant's date of birth that falls not less than 4 years or more
- 3 than 5 years after the license is issued or renewed, as applicable.
- 4 Except as provided in subsections (8) and (9), THIS SECTION, a
- 5 renewal of a license under section 5b shall , except as provided in
- 6 this section, be issued in the same manner as an original license
- 7 issued under section 5b.
- 8 (2) <del>(3)</del> Subject to subsections (7) AND (8), and <del>(9),</del> an
- 9 application to renew a license to carry a concealed pistol may be
- 10 submitted not more than 6 months before the expiration of the
- 11 current license. A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, THE
- 12 UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RESERVE, OR THE MICHIGAN NATIONAL GUARD
- 13 WHO IS ON ORDERS TO A DUTY STATION OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE MAY SUBMIT
- 14 HIS OR HER APPLICATION TO RENEW A LICENSE TO CARRY A CONCEALED
- 15 PISTOL BY FIRST-CLASS MAIL, CONTAINING THE REQUIRED FEE, A
- 16 NOTARIZED APPLICATION, THE LICENSEE'S ADDRESS OF RECORD WITHIN THE
- 17 STATE, THE LICENSEE'S ORDERS TO REPORT TO A DUTY STATION OUTSIDE OF
- 18 THIS STATE, AND IF THE LICENSEE DESIRES TO HAVE HIS OR HER
- 19 APPLICATION RECEIPT, RENEWAL LICENSE, OR ANY OTHER NOTICES MAILED
- 20 TO HIS OR HER ADDRESS OF ASSIGNMENT OR DEPLOYMENT, A LETTER
- 21 REQUESTING THAT ACTION INCLUDING THE ADDRESS OF ASSIGNMENT OR
- 22 DEPLOYMENT. IF THE CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSING BOARD APPROVES A
- 23 RENEWAL LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY CLERK SHALL SEND THE
- 24 LICENSE TO THE LICENSEE BY FIRST-CLASS MAIL IN A SEALED ENVELOPE.
- 25 IF THE LICENSEE IS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, THE
- 26 UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RESERVE, OR THE MICHIGAN NATIONAL GUARD
- 27 WHO IS ON ORDERS TO A DUTY STATION OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE AND

- 1 REQUESTS THAT HIS OR HER LICENSE BE SENT TO THE ADDRESS OF
- 2 ASSIGNMENT OR DEPLOYMENT, THE COUNTY CLERK SHALL MAIL THE LICENSE
- 3 TO THE LICENSEE AT THE ADDRESS OF ASSIGNMENT OR DEPLOYMENT PROVIDED
- 4 IN THE RENEWAL APPLICATION. If the concealed weapon licensing board
- 5 approves the renewal, the effective date of the renewal license is
- 6 the date of expiration of the current license or the date of
- 7 approval of the renewal, whichever is later, and the date of
- 8 expiration is the applicant's date of birth which is not less than
- 9 4 years or more than 5 years from the effective date of the
- 10 license.
- 11 (3) (4) The concealed weapon licensing board shall issue or
- 12 deny issuance of a renewal license within 60 days after the
- 13 application for renewal is properly submitted. The county clerk
- 14 shall issue the applicant a receipt for his or her renewal
- 15 application at the time the application is submitted. IF THE
- 16 RENEWAL APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED BY A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES
- 17 ARMED FORCES, THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RESERVE, OR THE
- 18 MICHIGAN NATIONAL GUARD WHO IS ON ORDERS TO A DUTY STATION OUTSIDE
- 19 OF THIS STATE, THE COUNTY CLERK SHALL MAIL THE RECEIPT TO THE
- 20 LICENSEE BY FIRST-CLASS MAIL. The receipt shall contain all of the
- 21 following:
- 22 (a) The name of the applicant.
- 23 (b) The date and time the receipt is issued.
- 24 (c) The amount paid.
- 25 (d) A statement that the receipt is for a license renewal.
- (e) A statement of whether the applicant qualifies for an
- 27 extension under subsection (5). (4).

- 1 (f) The name of the county in which the receipt is issued.
- 2 (g) An impression of the county seal.
- 3 (4) (5)—If the concealed weapon licensing board fails to deny
- 4 or issue a renewal license to the person within 60 days as required
- 5 under subsection  $\frac{(4)}{(4)}$ , (3), the expiration date of the current
- 6 license is extended by 180 days or until the renewal license is
- 7 issued, whichever occurs first. This subsection does not apply
- 8 unless the person pays the renewal fee at the time the renewal
- 9 application is submitted and the person has submitted a receipt
- 10 from a police agency that confirms that a background check has been
- 11 requested by the applicant.
- 12 (5) (6) A person carrying a concealed pistol after the
- 13 expiration date of his or her license pursuant to an extension
- 14 under subsection (5)—(4) shall keep the receipt issued by the
- 15 county clerk under subsection (4)—(3) and his or her expired
- 16 license in his or her possession at all times that he or she is
- 17 carrying the pistol. For the purposes of this act, the receipt is
- 18 considered to be part of the license to carry a concealed pistol
- 19 until a renewal license is issued or denied. Failing to have the
- 20 receipt and expired license in possession while carrying a
- 21 concealed pistol or failing to display the receipt to a peace
- 22 officer upon request is a violation of this act.
- (6) <del>(7)</del> The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c)
- 24 are waived for an applicant who is a retired police officer or
- 25 retired law enforcement officer.
- **26** (7) (8)—The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c)
- 27 for an applicant who is applying for a renewal of a license under

- 1 this act are waived except that the applicant shall certify that he
- 2 or she has completed at least 3 hours' review of the training
- 3 described under section 5b(7)(c) and has had at least 1 hour of
- 4 firing range time in the 6 months immediately preceding the
- 5 subsequent application.
- 6 (8) (9) Beginning January 1, 2007, an applicant who is
- 7 applying for a renewal of a license issued under section 5b is not
- 8 required to have fingerprints taken again under section 5b(9) if
- 9 all of the following conditions have been met:
- 10 (a) There has been established a system for the department of
- 11 state police to save and maintain in its automated fingerprint
- 12 identification system (AFIS) database all fingerprints that are
- 13 submitted to the department of state police under section 5b.
- 14 (b) The applicant's fingerprints have been submitted to and
- 15 maintained by the department of state police as described in
- 16 subdivision (a) for ongoing comparison with the automated
- 17 fingerprint identification system (AFIS) database.
