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SENATE BILL No. 1044

September 10, 2014, Introduced by Senators WHITMER, ANANICH, WARREN, YOUNG, HOOD, BIEDA and GREGORY and referred to the Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing.

A bill to require employers to provide information about insurance coverage related to reproductive health choices to current and prospective employees; to specify methods of disclosure; and to provide for sanctions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "reproductive health coverage information act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Employee" means an individual who is employed by an employer for compensation.
 - (b) "Employer" means an individual or a private, public, or

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- 1 governmental entity doing business in this state who employs 1 or
- 2 more individuals for compensation.
- 3 (c) "Reproductive health coverage information" means
- 4 information concerning employer-provided health coverage for
- 5 prescription contraception, including the existence or lack of
- 6 coverage and the extent of coverage.
- 7 Sec. 3. (1) An employer shall notify each applicant for
- 8 employment of reproductive health coverage information using all of
- 9 the following methods:
- 10 (a) Informing the prospective employee in writing before the
- 11 offer of employment.
- 12 (b) Including the reproductive health coverage information in
- 13 any posting or advertisement for the employment.
- 14 (c) If the employer is a corporation, posting the reproductive
- 15 health coverage information on the corporate website.
- 16 (2) An employer shall give each employee written notice of a
- 17 change in reproductive health coverage information at least 90 days
- 18 before the change takes effect.
- 19 Sec. 4. A person who violates this act is responsible for a
- 20 state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of
- 21 not more than \$5,000.00 for each violation.
