(1) A person circulating a RECALL petition shall be a qualified and registered elector in the electoral district of the official sought to be recalled and shall attach thereto his certificate stating that he is a qualified and registered elector in the electoral district of the official sought to be recalled and shall state the city or the township wherein he resides and his post office address; further, that STATE IN THE CERTIFICATE OF CIRCULATOR HIS OR HER RESIDENCE ADDRESS AND THAT HE OR SHE IS 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND A UNITED STATES CITIZEN. IN ADDITION, THE CERTIFICATE OF CIRCULATOR SHALL INDICATE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
