HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION V

A joint resolution to petition the congress of the United States to call a convention to propose amendments to the constitution of the United States to require a balanced federal budget.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
- 2 state of Michigan, That pursuant to article V of the constitution
- 3 of the United States, the legislature of the state of Michigan
- 4 petitions the congress of the United States of America, at its
- 5 session, to call a convention of the states limited to proposing an
- 6 amendment to the constitution of the United States requiring that

- in the absence of a national emergency[, including, but not limited to, an attack by a foreign nation or terrorist organization within the United States of America,] the total of all federal
- 2 appropriations made by the congress for any fiscal year may not
- 3 exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for that fiscal
- 4 year, together with any related and appropriate fiscal restraints.
- 5 Resolved further, That this application is to be considered as
- 6 covering the balanced budget amendment language of the presently
- 7 outstanding balanced budget applications from other states,
- 8 including, but not limited to, previously adopted applications from
- 9 Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Indiana, Iowa,
- 10 Kansas, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New
- 11 Mexico, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Texas; and this
- 12 application shall be aggregated with those applications for the
- 13 purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require
- 14 the calling of a convention for proposing a balanced budget
- 15 amendment, but shall not be aggregated with any applications on any
- 16 other subject.
- 17 Resolved further, That this application constitutes a
- 18 continuing application in accordance with article V of the
- 19 constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at
- 20 least two-thirds of the several states have made applications on
- 21 the same subject. It supersedes all previous applications by this
- 22 legislature on the same subject.
- 23 Resolved further, That certified copies of this joint
- 24 resolution be transmitted by the secretary of state to the
- 25 president of the United States Senate, to the speaker of the United
- 26 States House of Representatives, and to each member of this state's
- 27 delegation to the congress and that printed copies be sent to each
