

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION E

January 16, 2013, Introduced by Senator PROOS and referred to the Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 13 of article IV, to limit the legislative session.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to limit the legislative session, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

ARTICLE IV

Sec. 13. **EXCEPT WHEN THE LEGISLATURE IS CALLED TO CONVENE ON EXTRAORDINARY OCCASIONS, THE LEGISLATURE SHALL ONLY MEET AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.** The legislature shall meet at the seat of government on the second Wednesday in January of each year at

1 twelve o'clock noon. Each regular session shall adjourn without
2 day, on a day determined by concurrent resolution, at twelve
3 o'clock noon. Any business, bill or joint resolution pending at the
4 final adjournment of a regular session held in an odd numbered year
5 shall carry over with the same status to the next regular session.

6 **IN 2015 AND EVERY YEAR AFTER 2015, THE LEGISLATURE SHALL MEET FOR**
7 **NOT MORE THAN 90 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.**

8 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
9 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
10 in the manner provided by law.
