## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION V

May 23, 2013, Introduced by Senators GREEN, JONES, COLBECK, PAPPAGEORGE, PROOS, ROBERTSON, MARLEAU, BOOHER and JANSEN and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A joint resolution to petition the congress of the United States to call a convention to propose amendments to the constitution of the United States to require a balanced federal budget.

ARTICLE V

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That pursuant to article V of the constitution of the United States, the legislature of the state of Michigan petitions the congress of the United States of America, at its session, to call a convention of the states limited to proposing an

- 1 amendment to the constitution of the United States requiring that
- 2 in the absence of a national emergency the total of all federal
- 3 appropriations made by the congress for any fiscal year may not
- 4 exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for that fiscal
- 5 year, together with any related and appropriate fiscal restraints.
- 6 Resolved further, That this application is to be considered as
- 7 covering the balanced budget amendment language of the presently
- 8 outstanding balanced budget applications from other states,
- 9 including, but not limited to, previously-adopted applications from
- 10 Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Indiana, Iowa,
- 11 Kansas, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New
- 12 Mexico, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Texas; and this
- 13 application shall be aggregated with those applications for the
- 14 purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require
- 15 the calling of a convention for proposing a balanced budget
- 16 amendment, but shall not be aggregated with any applications on any
- 17 other subject.
- 18 Resolved further, That this application constitutes a
- 19 continuing application in accordance with article V of the
- 20 constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at
- 21 least two-thirds of the several states have made applications on
- 22 the same subject. It supersedes all previous applications by this
- 23 legislature on the same subject.
- 24 Resolved further, That certified copies of this joint
- 25 resolution be transmitted by the secretary of state to the
- 26 president of the United States Senate, to the speaker of the United
- 27 States House of Representatives, and to each member of this state's

- 1 delegation to the congress and that printed copies be sent to each
- 2 house of each state legislature in the United States.
