SUMMARY:

<u>House Bill 5033</u> would repeal the section of the Revised Statutes of 1846 which defines an "insane person."

Currently, an insane person "shall be construed to include an idiot, a non compos, a lunatic and an otherwise distracted person."

(Non compos, or non compos mentis, means not in one's right mind).

MCL 8.3g.
