SUMMARY:

Under the Michigan Vehicle Code, a person is prohibited from operating a commercial snow removal vehicle to remove snow or ice on a public street, highway, or in a parking lot accessible for use by the public unless the vehicle is operated with at least one flashing, rotating or oscillating *yellow* or *amber* light clearly visible from 500 feet within use. House Bill 5247 would amend the Code to add *green* light to this provision. Also, the bill would not prohibit the use of a flashing, rotating or oscillating green light by a fire service.
