Senate Bills 44 and 45 (as reported without amendment)

## **CONTENT**

<u>Senate Bill 44</u> would amend the Michigan Election Law to require a statewide presidential primary election to be conducted on the third Tuesday in March, instead of the fourth Tuesday in February, in each presidential election year.

<u>Senate Bill 45</u> would amend the Election Law to move the February regular election date from the fourth Tuesday in February to the third Tuesday in March, in each presidential election year when a statewide presidential primary was held.

The bills are tie-barred. Each bill would take effect 90 days after the date it was enacted.
