CONTENT

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to revise the Michigan Compiled Law citation in the sentencing guideline for a third or subsequent offense of carrying a concealed pistol or taser in a prohibited place under Section 50 of the handgun licensure law. A violation is a Class F felony against the public safety and has a statutory maximum penalty of four years' imprisonment.

(Section 50 prohibits a person who is licensed to carry a concealed pistol, or who is exempt from licensure, from carrying a concealed pistol or taser on certain premises, commonly called weapon-free or no-carry zones.)

The bill would take effect 90 days after its enactment and is tie-barred to Senate Bill 442. (Senate Bill 442 (S-2), as reported from the Senate Judiciary Committee, would amend the handgun licensure law to allow a concealed pistol licensee to request and receive an indorsement exempting him or her from the no-carry zone prohibition.)
