Until December 31, 2013, for the name of a candidate 2 for a city office, including a ward office, to appear on the 3 official February primary election ballots for use in the city, a 4 nominating petition shall be filed with the city clerk not later 5 than 4 p.m. on the twelfth Tuesday before the February primary. 6 Beginning January 1, 2014, for the name of a candidate for a city 7 office, including a ward office, to appear on the official February primary election ballots for use in the city, a nominating petition shall be filed with the city clerk not later than 4 p.m. on the 10 fifteenth Tuesday before the February primary. Until December 31, 11 2013, if a charter provides for nomination by caucus or by filing a
