SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4505

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 7521 (MCL 333.7521), as amended by 2001 PA 236.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7521. (1) The following property is subject to
- 2 forfeiture:
- 3 (a) A prescription form, controlled substance, an imitation
- 4 controlled substance, a controlled substance analogue, or other
- 5 drug that has been manufactured, distributed, dispensed, used,
- 6 possessed, or acquired in violation of this article.
- 7 (b) A raw material, product, or equipment of any kind that is
- 8 used, or intended for use, in manufacturing, compounding,
- 9 processing, delivering, importing, or exporting a controlled
- 10 substance, a controlled substance analogue, or other drug in
- 11 violation of this article; or a raw material, product, or equipment

- 1 of any kind that is intended for use in manufacturing, compounding,
- 2 processing, delivering, importing, or exporting an imitation
- 3 controlled substance in violation of section 7341.
- 4 (c) Property that is used, or intended for use, as a container
- 5 for property described in subdivision (a) or (b).
- **6** (d) Except as provided in subparagraphs (i) to (iv), a
- 7 conveyance, including an aircraft, vehicle, or vessel used or
- 8 intended for use, to transport, or in any manner to facilitate the
- 9 transportation, for the purpose of sale or receipt of property
- 10 described in subdivision (a) or (b):
- (i) A conveyance used by a person as a common carrier in the
- 12 transaction of business as a common carrier is not subject to
- 13 forfeiture unless it appears that the owner or other person in
- 14 charge of the conveyance is a consenting party or privy to a
- 15 violation of this article.
- 16 (ii) A conveyance is not subject to forfeiture by reason of any
- 17 act or omission established by the owner of that conveyance to have
- 18 been committed or omitted without the owner's knowledge or consent.
- 19 (iii) A conveyance is not subject to forfeiture for a violation
- 20 of section 7403(2)(c) or (d), section 7404, or section 7341(4).
- 21 (iv) A forfeiture of a conveyance encumbered by a bona fide
- 22 security interest is subject to the interest of the secured party
- 23 who neither had knowledge of nor consented to the act or omission.
- (e) Books, records, and research products and materials,
- 25 including formulas, microfilm, tapes, and data used, or intended
- 26 for use, in violation of this article.
- 27 (f) Any thing of value that is furnished or intended to be

- 1 furnished in exchange for a controlled substance, an imitation
- 2 controlled substance, or other drug in violation of this article
- 3 that is traceable to an exchange for a controlled substance, an
- 4 imitation controlled substance, or other drug in violation of this
- 5 article or that is used or intended to be used to facilitate any
- 6 violation of this article including, but not limited to, money,
- 7 negotiable instruments, or securities. To the extent of the
- 8 interest of an owner, a thing of value is not subject to forfeiture
- 9 under this subdivision by reason of any act or omission that is
- 10 established by the owner of the item to have been committed or
- 11 omitted without the owner's knowledge or consent. Any money that is
- 12 found in close proximity to any property that is subject to
- 13 forfeiture under subdivision (a), (b), (c), (d), or (e) is presumed
- 14 to be subject to forfeiture under this subdivision. This
- 15 presumption may be rebutted by clear and convincing evidence.
- 16 (g) Any other drug paraphernalia not described in subdivision
- **17** (b) or (c).
- 18 (2) THE PLAINTIFF IN A FORFEITURE ACTION UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 19 HAS THE BURDEN OF PROVING A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE BY CLEAR AND
- 20 CONVINCING EVIDENCE. THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO FORFEITURE
- 21 PROCEEDINGS COMMENCED UNDER THIS ARTICLE ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
- 22 DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION.
- 23 (3) $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ As used in this section, "imitation controlled
- 24 substance" means that term as defined in section 7341.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 26 after the date it is enacted into law.
