SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5288

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 947a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 947A. (1) IF A MILITARY SPOUSE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS
- 2 OF SECTION 947 IS ADMITTED TO THE BAR OF THIS STATE, AND IS NOT
- 3 SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE, SUSPENSION, OR DISBARMENT FOR MISCONDUCT
- 4 UNDER SECTION 904, HIS OR HER ADMISSION TO THE BAR OF THIS STATE IS
- 5 VALID UNTIL THE DATE THE BOARD OF LAW EXAMINERS RECEIVES A NOTICE
- 6 UNDER SUBSECTION (2).
- 7 (2) A MILITARY SPOUSE DESCRIBED IN SECTION 947 WHO IS ADMITTED
- 8 TO THE BAR OF THIS STATE SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD OF LAW EXAMINERS IN
- 9 WRITING IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING EVENTS OCCUR:

- (A) THE SERVICE MEMBER TO WHOM THE MILITARY SPOUSE IS MARRIED 1
- 2 IS NO LONGER AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ON ACTIVE DUTY IN THE ARMED
- 3 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 4 (B) THE MILITARY SPOUSE AND SERVICE MEMBER ARE NO LONGER
- 5 MARRIED.
- 6 (C) THE SERVICE MEMBER RECEIVES A PERMANENT TRANSFER TO A DUTY
- STATION OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE. HOWEVER, IF THE SERVICE MEMBER 7
- RECEIVES AN UNACCOMPANIED OR REMOTE ASSIGNMENT WITH NO DEPENDENTS 8
- AUTHORIZED, THE MILITARY SPOUSE MAY CONTINUE TO PRACTICE LAW IN 9
- THIS STATE UNTIL THE SERVICE MEMBER IS SUBSEQUENTLY ASSIGNED TO A 10
- 11 DUTY STATION AT WHICH DEPENDENTS ARE AUTHORIZED, AND THE MILITARY
- 12 SPOUSE SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD WHEN THAT SUBSEQUENT ASSIGNMENT
- 13 OCCURS.
- (3) A MILITARY SPOUSE ATTORNEY MUST PROVIDE A NOTICE TO THE 14
- BOARD OF LAW EXAMINERS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) WITHIN 30 DAYS 15
- AFTER AN EVENT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) FIRST OCCURS. HOWEVER, 16
- IF THE OCCURRENCE OF THAT EVENT IS DUE TO THE DEATH OR DISABILITY 17
- OF THE SERVICE MEMBER, THE MILITARY SPOUSE ATTORNEY MUST PROVIDE 18
- 19 THE NOTICE WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DEATH OR DISABILITY OF THE
- 20 SERVICE MEMBER.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 23 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- unless Senate Bill No. (request no. 02306'15) or House Bill 24
- 25 No. 5289 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
