- revoked, canceled, or renewed in accordance with and governed bythis act.
 - (2) A person, before operating a moped upon a highway shall procure a special restricted license to operate a moped unless the person has a valid operator's or chauffeur's license. A special restricted license to operate a moped may be issued to a person 15

- 1 years of age or older if the person satisfies the secretary of
