## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5163

A bill to amend 2003 PA 258, entitled "Land bank fast track act," by amending section 18 (MCL 124.768); and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18. (1) The land bank fast track fund is created under
- 2 the jurisdiction and control of the state authority and may be
- 3 administered to secure any notes and bonds of the state authority.
- 4 (2) The state authority may receive money or other assets from
- 5 any source for deposit into the fund. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
- 6 TRANSFER ALL MONEY IN THE URBAN LAND ASSEMBLY LOAN FUND CREATED
- 7 UNDER FORMER 1981 PA 171 TO THE FUND, AND CLOSE THE URBAN LAND
- 8 ASSEMBLY LOAN FUND. ANY LOAN REPAYMENTS THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE
- 9 MADE TO THE URBAN LAND ASSEMBLY LOAN FUND SHALL BE MADE TO THE

## 1 FUND.

- 2 (3) The state authority shall credit to the fund interest and
- 3 earnings from fund investments.
- 4 (4) (3) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year
- 5 shall remain in the fund and shall not lapse to any other fund.
- 6 (5) (4) The state authority shall expend money from the fund
- 7 only for 1 or more of the following:
- 8 (a) Costs to clear or quiet title to property held by the
- 9 state authority.
- 10 (b) To repay a loan made to the state authority under section
- 11 2f of 1855 PA 105, MCL 21.142f.
- 12 (c) Any other purposes provided in this act.
- (6) (5) The state authority shall deposit into the fund all
- 14 money it receives from the sale or transfer of property under this
- 15 act, subject to section 8. The state authority shall credit to the
- 16 fund the proceeds of the sale of notes or bonds to the extent
- 17 provided for in the authorizing resolution of the state authority,
- 18 and any other money made available to the state authority for the
- 19 purposes of the fund.
- 20 Enacting section 1. The Michigan urban land assembly act, 1981
- 21 PA 171, MCL 125.1851 to 125.1861, is repealed.
- 22 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 23 after the date it is enacted into law.
