SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4187

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 377d; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 377D. (1) A PERSON WHO WILLFULLY AND MALICIOUSLY DAMAGES,
- 2 DESTROYS, INJURES, DEFACES, DISMANTLES, TAMPERS WITH, OR REMOVES A
- 3 TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE IS GUILTY OF A CRIME AS FOLLOWS:
- 4 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISIONS (B) AND (C), THE PERSON
- 5 IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE
- 6 THAN 93 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
- 7 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND HAS 1 PRIOR
- 8 CONVICTION FOR VIOLATING THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 9 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 180 DAYS OR A FINE OF
- 10 NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

- 1 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND HAS 2 OR MORE PRIOR
- 2 CONVICTIONS FOR VIOLATING THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 3 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF
- 4 NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 5 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE PERSON FROM BEING
- 6 CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR SENTENCED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF
- 7 LAW ARISING OUT OF THE SAME TRANSACTION AS THE VIOLATION OF THIS
- 8 SECTION IN ADDITION TO BEING CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR
- 9 SENTENCED FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
- 10 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE" MEANS A
- 11 SIGN, SIGNAL, ELECTRONIC TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGN OR SIGNAL, MARKING,
- 12 LIGHT POST, RAILROAD SIGN OR SIGNAL, OR DEVICE NOT INCONSISTENT
- 13 WITH THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 TO 257.923,
- 14 PLACED OR ERECTED BY AUTHORITY OF A PUBLIC BODY OR OFFICIAL HAVING
- 15 JURISDICTION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING, WARNING, OR GUIDING
- 16 TRAFFIC, MAINTAINING HIGHWAY SAFETY, OR PROVIDING INFORMATION TO
- 17 MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS.
- 18 Enacting section 1. Section 616 of the Michigan vehicle code,
- 19 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.616, is repealed.
- 20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 21 after the date it is enacted into law.
