## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4445

## A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 28.297), as amended by 2011 PA 158.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) The secretary of state may provide a commercial
- 2 look-up service of records maintained under this act. For each
- 3 individual record looked up, the secretary of state shall charge a
- 4 fee specified annually by the legislature, or if the legislature
- 5 does not specify a fee, a market-based price established by the
- 6 secretary of state. The secretary of state shall process a
- 7 commercial look-up request only if the request is in a form or

- 1 format as prescribed by the secretary of state. Fees collected
- 2 under this subsection on and after October 1, 2005 through October
- 3 1, <del>2015</del> **2019** shall be credited to the transportation administration
- 4 collection fund created in section 810b of the Michigan vehicle
- 5 code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.810b.
- 6 (2) The secretary of state shall establish and maintain a
- 7 computerized central file of the information contained on
- 8 application forms received under this act. The computerized central
- 9 file shall be interfaced with the law enforcement information
- 10 network as provided in the C.J.I.S. policy council act, 1974 PA
- 11 163, MCL 28.211 to 28.215.
- 12 (3) Except as provided in section 10(2), the secretary of
- 13 state shall not provide an entire computerized central file or
- 14 other file of records maintained under this act to a
- 15 nongovernmental person or entity, unless the purchaser pays the
- 16 prescribed fee for each individual record contained within the
- 17 computerized file.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
- **19** 1, 2015.
