SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5412

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1307c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1307C. THE STATE POLICY UNDER SECTION 1307A SHALL INCLUDE
- 2 AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS CONCERNING USE OF
- 3 EMERGENCY SECLUSION AND EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT:
- 4 (A) EMERGENCY SECLUSION AND EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT MAY
- 5 BE USED ONLY UNDER EMERGENCY SITUATIONS AND ONLY IF ESSENTIAL TO
- 6 PROVIDING FOR THE SAFETY OF THE PUPIL OR SAFETY OF ANOTHER.
- 7 (B) EMERGENCY SECLUSION AND EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT MAY
- 8 NOT BE USED IN PLACE OF APPROPRIATE LESS RESTRICTIVE INTERVENTIONS.
- 9 (C) EMERGENCY SECLUSION AND EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT SHALL
- 10 BE PERFORMED IN A MANNER THAT, BASED ON RESEARCH AND EVIDENCE, IS

- 1 SAFE, APPROPRIATE, AND PROPORTIONATE TO AND SENSITIVE TO THE
- 2 PUPIL'S SEVERITY OF BEHAVIOR, CHRONOLOGICAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL AGE,
- 3 PHYSICAL SIZE, GENDER, PHYSICAL CONDITION, MEDICAL CONDITION,
- 4 PSYCHIATRIC CONDITION, AND PERSONAL HISTORY, INCLUDING ANY HISTORY
- 5 OF PHYSICAL OR SEXUAL ABUSE OR OTHER TRAUMA.
- 6 (D) A REQUIREMENT THAT SCHOOL PERSONNEL SHALL CALL KEY
- 7 IDENTIFIED PERSONNEL FOR HELP FROM WITHIN THE SCHOOL BUILDING
- 8 EITHER IMMEDIATELY AT THE ONSET OF AN EMERGENCY SITUATION OR, IF IT
- 9 IS REASONABLE UNDER THE PARTICULAR CIRCUMSTANCES FOR SCHOOL
- 10 PERSONNEL TO BELIEVE THAT DIVERTING THEIR ATTENTION TO CALLING FOR
- 11 HELP WOULD INCREASE THE RISK TO THE SAFETY OF THE PUPIL OR TO THE
- 12 SAFETY OF OTHERS, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE ONCE THE CIRCUMSTANCES NO
- 13 LONGER SUPPORT SUCH A BELIEF.
- 14 (E) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE
- 15 SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY MUST ENSURE THAT
- 16 SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS ARE INFORMED OF AND UNDERSTAND THE PROCEDURES
- 17 REGARDING USE OF EMERGENCY SECLUSION AND EMERGENCY PHYSICAL
- 18 RESTRAINT. THIS REQUIREMENT MAY BE SATISFIED USING ONLINE TRAINING
- 19 AND AN ONLINE ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF UNDERSTANDING DEVELOPED OR APPROVED
- 20 BY THE DEPARTMENT AND COMPLETED BY THE SUBSTITUTE TEACHER.
- 21 (F) EMERGENCY SECLUSION SHOULD NOT BE USED ANY LONGER THAN
- 22 NECESSARY, BASED ON RESEARCH AND EVIDENCE, TO ALLOW A PUPIL TO
- 23 REGAIN CONTROL OF HIS OR HER BEHAVIOR TO THE POINT THAT THE
- 24 EMERGENCY SITUATION NECESSITATING THE USE OF EMERGENCY SECLUSION IS
- 25 ENDED AND GENERALLY NO LONGER THAN 15 MINUTES FOR AN ELEMENTARY
- 26 SCHOOL PUPIL OR 20 MINUTES FOR A MIDDLE SCHOOL OR HIGH SCHOOL
- 27 PUPIL. IF AN EMERGENCY SECLUSION LASTS LONGER THAN 15 MINUTES FOR

- 1 AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PUPIL OR 20 MINUTES FOR A MIDDLE SCHOOL OR
- 2 HIGH SCHOOL PUPIL, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE REQUIRED:
- 3 (i) ADDITIONAL SUPPORT, WHICH MAY INCLUDE A CHANGE OF STAFF, OR
- 4 INTRODUCING A NURSE, SPECIALIST, OR ADDITIONAL KEY IDENTIFIED
- 5 PERSONNEL.
- 6 (ii) DOCUMENTATION TO EXPLAIN THE EXTENSION BEYOND THE TIME
- 7 LIMIT.
- 8 (G) EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT SHOULD NOT BE USED ANY LONGER
- 9 THAN NECESSARY, BASED ON RESEARCH AND EVIDENCE, TO ALLOW A PUPIL TO
- 10 REGAIN CONTROL OF HIS OR HER BEHAVIOR TO THE POINT THAT THE
- 11 EMERGENCY SITUATION NECESSITATING THE USE OF EMERGENCY PHYSICAL
- 12 RESTRAINT IS ENDED AND GENERALLY NO LONGER THAN 10 MINUTES. IF AN
- 13 EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT LASTS LONGER THAN 10 MINUTES, ALL OF
- 14 THE FOLLOWING ARE REQUIRED:
- 15 (i) ADDITIONAL SUPPORT, WHICH MAY INCLUDE A CHANGE OF STAFF, OR
- 16 INTRODUCING A NURSE, SPECIALIST, OR ADDITIONAL KEY IDENTIFIED
- 17 PERSONNEL.
- 18 (ii) DOCUMENTATION TO EXPLAIN THE EXTENSION BEYOND THE TIME
- 19 LIMIT.
- 20 (H) WHILE USING EMERGENCY SECLUSION OR EMERGENCY PHYSICAL
- 21 RESTRAINT, SCHOOL PERSONNEL MUST DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 22 (i) INVOLVE KEY IDENTIFIED PERSONNEL TO PROTECT THE CARE,
- 23 WELFARE, DIGNITY, AND SAFETY OF THE PUPIL.
- 24 (ii) CONTINUALLY OBSERVE THE PUPIL IN EMERGENCY SECLUSION OR
- 25 EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT FOR INDICATIONS OF PHYSICAL DISTRESS
- 26 AND SEEK MEDICAL ASSISTANCE IF THERE IS A CONCERN.
- 27 (iii) DOCUMENT OBSERVATIONS.

- (iv) ENSURE TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, IN LIGHT OF THE ONGOING 1
- 2 EMERGENCY SITUATION, THAT THE EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT DOES NOT
- INTERFERE WITH THE PUPIL'S ABILITY TO COMMUNICATE USING THE PUPIL'S 3
- 4 PRIMARY MODE OF COMMUNICATION.
- 5 (v) ENSURE THAT AT ALL TIMES DURING THE USE OF EMERGENCY
- SECLUSION OR EMERGENCY PHYSICAL RESTRAINT THERE ARE SCHOOL
- PERSONNEL PRESENT WHO CAN COMMUNICATE WITH THE PUPIL USING THE 7
- PUPIL'S PRIMARY MODE OF COMMUNICATION. 8
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 9
- after the date it is enacted into law. 10
- 11 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- unless all of the following bills of the 98th Legislature are 12
