

HOUSE BILL No. 5591

April 21, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Cole, McCready, Rendon and Aaron Miller and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 305, entitled
"Uniform electronic transactions act,"
(MCL 450.831 to 450.849) by adding section 5a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 5A. IF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS APPLY TO MORE THAN [250]

1 LOTS OR PARCELS OF REAL PROPERTY IN A SINGLE DEVELOPMENT AND THE
2 LAW OF THIS STATE ALLOWS THE OWNERS OF THE REAL PROPERTY TO AMEND,
3 REAFFIRM, OR REPEAL THE RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS, THE OWNER OF A LOT
4 OR PARCEL THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS MAY CONSENT
5 TO AMEND, REAFFIRM, OR REPEAL THE RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS, IN WHOLE
6 OR IN PART, BY AN ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE.

7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
8 after the date it is enacted into law.
