A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 459 (MCL 750.459), as amended by 2014 PA 331.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 459. (1) A person who SHALL NOT knowingly transports
- 2 TRANSPORT or causes CAUSE to be transported, or aids AID or assists
- 3 ASSIST in obtaining transportation for, by any means of conveyance,
- 4 into, through, or across this state, any person for the purpose of
- 5 prostitution or with the intent and purpose to induce, entice, or
- 6 compel that person to become a prostitute. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES
- 7 THIS SUBSECTION is guilty of a felony —punishable by imprisonment
- 8 for not more than 20 years OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$20,000.00,

- 1 SERVICES THAT INCLUDE OR FACILITATE TRAVEL FOR THE PURPOSE OF
