## SENATE BILL NO. 95

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending section 181 (MCL 600.181), as amended by 2008 PA 545.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 181. (1) The justice system fund is created in the state treasury. The money in the fund shall be used as provided in this
- 4 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the justice system
- 5 fund deposits of proceeds from the collection of revenue from court
- 6 assessments and costs designated by law for deposit in the fund and
- 7 shall credit all income from investment credited to the fund by the
- 8 state treasurer. The state treasurer may invest money in the fund
- 9 in any manner authorized by law for the investment of state money.
- 10 However, an investment shall not interfere with any apportionment,
- 11 allocation, or payment of money as required by this section. The

- 1 unencumbered balance remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal
- 2 year shall remain in the fund and shall not revert to the general
- 3 fund.
- 4 (3) Each fiscal year, the state treasurer shall distribute the
- 5 proceeds of the fund monthly as follows:
- 6 (a) To the secondary road patrol and training fund created in
- 7 section 629e of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL
- 8 257.629e, an amount equal to \$10.00 multiplied by the number of
- 9 civil infraction actions on which assessments are collected each
- 10 month under section 629e or 907 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949
- 11 PA 300, MCL 257.629e and 257.907.
- 12 (b) The balance of the fund remaining after the allocation in
- 13 subdivision (a) shall be distributed as follows:
- (i) To the highway safety fund created in section 629e of the
- 15 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.629e, 23.66% of the
- 16 fund balance.
- (ii) To the jail reimbursement program fund created in section
- 18 629e of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.629e,
- 19 11.84% of the fund balance.
- 20 (iii) To the Michigan justice training fund created in section 5
- 21 of 1982 PA 302, MCL 18.425, 18.421 TO 18.430, 11.84% of the fund
- 22 balance.
- (iv) To the secretary of the legislative retirement system for
- 24 deposit with the state treasurer in the retirement fund created in
- 25 the Michigan legislative retirement system act, 1957 PA 261, MCL
- 26 38.1001 to 38.1080, 1.10% of the fund balance.
- (v) To the drug treatment courts COURT fund created in section

- 1 185, 2.73% of the fund balance.
- 2 (vi) To the state forensic  $\frac{1}{2}$  LABORATORY fund created in
- 3 section 3 of the forensic laboratory funding act, 1994 PA 35, MCL
- 4 12.203, 5.35% of the fund balance.
- 5 (vii) To the state court fund created in section 151a, 12.69%
- of the fund balance.
- 7 (viii) To the court equity fund created in section 151b, 24.33%
- of the fund balance. 8
- 9 (ix) To the state treasurer for monitoring of collection and
- 10 distribution of fund receipts, 0.98% of the fund balance.
- 11 (x) To the state court administrative office for management
- 12 assistance and audit of trial court collections, 0.98% of the fund
- 13 balance.
- 14 (xi) To the sexual assault victims' medical forensic
- 15 intervention and treatment fund CREATED IN SECTION 3 OF THE SEXUAL
- ASSAULT VICTIMS' MEDICAL FORENSIC INTERVENTION AND TREATMENT ACT, 16
- 17 2008 PA 546, MCL 400.1533, 2.65% of the fund balance.
- 18 (xii) To the children's advocacy center fund created in section
- 19 3 of the children's advocacy center act, 2008 PA 544, MCL 722.1043,
- 20 1.85% of the fund balance.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- after the date it is enacted into law. 22
- Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect 23
- unless Senate Bill No. 92 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into 24
- 25 law.
