## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. The probate courts of this state, subject SUBJECT to
the provisions of section 5 of Act No. 271 of the Public Acts of

1913, as last amended by Act No. 59 of the Public Acts of 1955,

1913 PA 271, MCL 399.5, A PROBATE COURT may order the destruction
of any of the following files and records when DESCRIBED IN THIS

SECTION IF more than 6 years have passed since the last order of
the court in the ease:CASE.
