

SENATE BILL No. 554

October 8, 2015, Introduced by Senators SCHUITMAKER and HORN and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 16206.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 16206. (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
2 WITH AN ENTITY THAT IS NOT AN AGENCY OF A STATE OR THE FEDERAL
3 GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE AN ELECTRONIC CONTINUING EDUCATION TRACKING
4 SYSTEM THAT PROVIDES AN ELECTRONIC RECORD OF THE CONTINUING
5 EDUCATION COURSES, CLASSES, OR PROGRAMS COMPLETED BY ALL OF THE
6 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER THIS ARTICLE. ALL
7 OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO AN ELECTRONIC SYSTEM PROVIDED BY AN
8 AGREEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION:

9 (A) ALL CONTINUING EDUCATION TRACKING PROVIDED BY THE SYSTEM
10 MUST ACCURATELY REFLECT THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER
11 THIS ARTICLE AND RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

1 (B) A CONFIRMATION OF COMPLETION OF CONTINUING EDUCATION
2 REQUIREMENTS GENERATED BY THE SYSTEM IS CONSIDERED VERIFICATION OF
3 COMPLETION OF THOSE REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE OR
4 REGISTRATION AND FOR PURPOSES OF ANY AUDIT OF LICENSEES OR
5 REGISTRANTS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

6 (C) THE SYSTEM MUST PROVIDE ACCESS TO CONTINUING EDUCATION
7 INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER
8 THIS ARTICLE TO THE INDIVIDUAL, TO THE APPROPRIATE BOARD FOR THE
9 INDIVIDUAL'S HEALTH PROFESSION, AND TO THE DEPARTMENT.

10 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE ANY RULES IT CONSIDERS
11 APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THIS SECTION.

12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
13 after the date it is enacted into law.
