(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 16206.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 16206. (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
- 2 WITH AN ENTITY THAT IS NOT AN AGENCY OF A STATE OR THE FEDERAL
- 3 GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE AN ELECTRONIC CONTINUING EDUCATION TRACKING
- 4 SYSTEM THAT PROVIDES AN ELECTRONIC RECORD OF THE CONTINUING
- 5 EDUCATION COURSES, CLASSES, OR PROGRAMS COMPLETED BY ALL OF THE
- 6 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER THIS ARTICLE. ALL
- 7 OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO AN ELECTRONIC SYSTEM PROVIDED BY AN
- 8 AGREEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION:
- 9 (A) ALL CONTINUING EDUCATION TRACKING PROVIDED BY THE SYSTEM
- 10 MUST ACCURATELY REFLECT THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER
- 11 THIS ARTICLE AND RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

- 1 (B) A CONFIRMATION OF COMPLETION OF CONTINUING EDUCATION
- 2 REQUIREMENTS GENERATED BY THE SYSTEM IS CONSIDERED VERIFICATION OF
- 3 COMPLETION OF THOSE REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE OR
- 4 REGISTRATION AND FOR PURPOSES OF ANY AUDIT OF LICENSEES OR

- 6 (C) THE SYSTEM MUST PROVIDE ACCESS TO CONTINUING EDUCATION
