

SENATE BILL No. 403

June 16, 2015, Introduced by Senators KNOLLENBERG, JONES, HORN, SCHUITMAKER, PROOS, HERTEL and MARLEAU and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 287, entitled

"An act to regulate pet shops, animal control shelters, and animal protection shelters; to establish uniform procedures and minimum requirements for adoption of dogs, cats, and ferrets; and to prescribe penalties and civil fines and to provide remedies,"

(MCL 287.331 to 287.340) by adding section 8b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 8B. (1) BEGINNING 60 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
2 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, EUTHANASIA OF A DOG OR CAT
3 THAT IS PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER SHALL ONLY
4 BE PERFORMED BY ADMINISTERING AN INJECTION OF A COMMERCIALY
5 PREPARED SOLUTION AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 7333 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH
6 CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7333.

7 (2) THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO A
8 VETERINARIAN LICENSED UNDER PART 188 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,
9 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.18801 TO 333.18838.

1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
2 after the date it is enacted into law.
