SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 501

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 302a (MCL 257.302a), as amended by 2006 PA 298.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 302a. (1) Except as otherwise provided by this act, a
- 2 nonresident operator of a motor vehicle who is the holder of a
- 3 VALID license to operate a motor vehicle in the ISSUED BY A country
- 4 in which he or she resides OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES is not
- 5 required to obtain a license to operate a passenger vehicle within
- 6 IN this state FOR THE PERIOD OF TIME THAT HE OR SHE IS LEGALLY
- 7 PRESENT IN THIS STATE if he or she does not receive compensation
- 8 for such operation. This subsection does not apply unless all of
- 9 the following conditions have been satisfied:
- 10 (a) The secretary of state determines that the standards of

- 1 the other country for licensing operators correspond substantially
- 2 to those of this state and that the other country extends the same
- 3 privileges to persons licensed to operate vehicles by this
- 4 state. THE OPERATOR HAS IN HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE POSSESSION A VALID
- 5 LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ISSUED BY A COUNTRY OTHER THAN
- 6 THE UNITED STATES.
- 7 (b) The secretary of state and the other country have
- 8 exchanged letters confirming the reciprocal extension of privileges
- 9 to operate vehicles. IF NO ENGLISH TRANSLATION APPEARS ON THE FRONT
- 10 OR BACK OF THE LICENSE, THE OPERATOR HAS IN HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE
- 11 POSSESSION AN INTERNATIONAL DRIVING PERMIT OR A COMPARABLE ENGLISH
- 12 TRANSLATION OF HIS OR HER VALID LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 13 (C) THE OPERATOR HAS IN HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE POSSESSION A
- 14 VALID PASSPORT, VALID VISA, OR OTHER VALID DOCUMENTATION TO VERIFY
- 15 HIS OR HER LEGAL PRESENCE IN THIS STATE.
- 16 (2) A VALID LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ISSUED BY A
- 17 COUNTRY OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES THAT IS ENHANCED OR OTHERWISE
- 18 SECURED TO COMPLY WITH THE WESTERN HEMISPHERE TRAVEL INITIATIVE
- 19 SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1).
- 20 (3) (2)—The secretary of state shall publish on its public
- 21 internet site a list of the countries for which reciprocal
- 22 operating privileges have been extended and withdrawn. If any
- 23 changes are made, a revised list shall be mailed to the courts,
- 24 prosecuting attorneys, and law enforcement agencies of this
- 25 state. ESTABLISH A UNIQUE DRIVER RECORD FOR AN INDIVIDUAL UPON
- 26 RECEIPT OF AN ABSTRACT OF CONVICTION FOR ANY OFFENSE COMMITTED IN
- 27 VIOLATION OF THIS ACT BY THAT INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OPERATING A MOTOR

- 1 VEHICLE IN THIS STATE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1). THE OPERATION
- 2 OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO POSSESSES A
- 3 VALID LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ISSUED BY A COUNTRY OTHER
- 4 THAN THE UNITED STATES IS SUBJECT TO THIS ACT.
- 5 (4) AN INDIVIDUAL FOR WHOM A UNIQUE DRIVER RECORD HAS BEEN
- 6 CREATED UNDER SUBSECTION (3) IS SUBJECT TO ALL FEES, FINES,
- 7 RESTRICTIONS, AND ENFORCEMENT AS IF HE OR SHE WERE LICENSED UNDER
- 8 THIS ACT.
- 9 (5) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 10 FROM ENTERING INTO A RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT AND EXCHANGING LETTERS
- 11 CONFIRMING THE EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES TO OPERATE VEHICLES WITH
- 12 ANOTHER COUNTRY.
- 13 (6) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE A LIST
- 14 OF THE COUNTRIES WITH WHICH IT HAS ENTERED INTO A RECIPROCAL
- 15 AGREEMENT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (5).
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
