SENATE BILL No. 885

April 14, 2016, Introduced by Senators MACGREGOR, HERTEL, KNOLLENBERG and HORN and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 545 (MCL 436.1545), as added by 2010 PA 213.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 545. (1) As used in this act, "nonpublic continuing care
- 2 retirement center" means a residential community that, as
- 3 determined by the commission, meets both of the following
- 4 conditions:
- 5 (a) Provides full-time residential housing predominantly for
- 6 individuals over the age of 62.
- 7 (B) MEETS 1 OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 8 (i) (b)—Is registered as a facility under the living care

- 3 (ii) IS A HOME FOR THE AGED LICENSED UNDER PART 213 OF THE

- 5 (2) The commission, upon—ON submission of a completed
- 6 application, shall grant a nonpublic continuing care retirement
- 7 center license to an applicant complying with this section. The

- 19 on the licensed premises beer, wine, mixed spirit drink, mixed wine
- 20 drink, and spirits, for consumption by a resident or the bona fide
- 21 guests accompanying the resident, only on the licensed premises.
- 22 (4) THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT ISSUE MORE THAN 20 LICENSES UNDER
- 23 THIS SECTION TO FACILITIES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) (B) (i). THE
- 24 COMMISSION SHALL NOT ISSUE MORE THAN 5 LICENSES UNDER THIS SECTION
- 25 TO HOMES FOR THE AGED DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) (B) (ii).
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 27 after the date it is enacted into law.
