## **SENATE BILL No. 967**

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 207. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2),
- 2 an asbestos abatement contractor shall not engage in any activity
- 3 involving the demolition, renovation, or encapsulation of friable
- 4 asbestos materials without first receiving a license from the
- 5 department.
- **6** (2) The licensing requirement of subsection (1) does not apply
- 7 to any of the following if engaged in an asbestos abatement project
- 8 that is incidental to the primary licensed trade and involves not
- 9 more than 160 square feet or 260 linear feet of friable asbestos
- 10 materials:
