HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1041

A bill to amend 1979 PA 218, entitled "Adult foster care facility licensing act," by amending section 24 (MCL 400.724).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 24. (1) A person who believes that this act or a rule
- 2 promulgated under this act may have been violated may request an
- 3 investigation of an adult foster care facility. The request shall
- 4 be submitted to the department in writing or the department shall
- 5 assist the person in reducing an oral complaint to writing within 7
- 6 days after the oral request is made.
- 7 (2) The substance of the complaint shall be provided to the
- 8 licensee not earlier than at the commencement of the on-site
- 9 inspection of the adult foster care facility which THAT takes place
- 10 pursuant ACCORDING to the complaint.

- 1 (3) The complaint, a copy of the complaint, or a record
- 2 published, released, or otherwise disclosed to the adult foster
- 3 care facility shall not disclose the name of the complainant or an

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- 4 adult resident named in the complaint unless the complainant or an
- 5 adult resident consents in writing to the disclosure or the
- 6 investigation results in an administrative hearing or a judicial
- 7 proceeding, or unless disclosure is considered essential to the
- 8 investigation by the department. If disclosure is considered
- 9 essential to the investigation, the complainant shall be given the
- 10 opportunity to withdraw the complaint before disclosure.
- 11 (4) Upon receipt of a complaint, the department shall
- 12 determine, based on the allegations presented, whether this act or
- 13 a rule promulgated under this act has been, is, or is in danger of
- 14 being violated. The department shall investigate the complaint
- 15 according to the urgency determined by the department. The
- 16 initiation of a complaint investigation shall commence within 15
- 17 days after receipt of the written complaint by the department.
- 18 (5) The department shall inform the complainant of its
- 19 findings. Within 30 days after the receipt of complaint, the
- 20 department shall provide the complainant a copy, if any, of the
- 21 written determination or a status report indicating when these
- 22 documents may be expected. The final report shall include a copy of
- 23 the original complaint. The complainant may request additional
- 24 copies of the documents listed in this subsection and shall
- 25 reimburse the department for the copies pursuant ACCORDING to
- 26 established policies and procedures.
- 27 (6) The department shall inform the licensee of the

- 1 department's findings at the same time that the department informs
- 2 the complainant pursuant to UNDER subsection (5).
- 3 (7) A written determination concerning a complaint shall be
- 4 available for public inspection, but the name of the complainant or
- 5 adult resident shall not be disclosed without the complainant's or
- 6 adult resident's consent.
- 7 (8) A complainant who is dissatisfied with the determination
- 8 or investigation by the department may request a hearing. A request
- 9 for a hearing shall be submitted in writing to the director within
- 10 30 days after the mailing of the department's findings as described
- 11 in subsection (5). Notice of the time and place of the hearing
- 12 shall be sent to the complainant and the adult foster care
- 13 facility. A complainant who is dissatisfied with the decision of
- 14 the director may appeal by filing with the clerk of the court an
- 15 affidavit setting forth the substance of the proceedings before the
- 16 department and the errors of law upon which the person relies, and
- 17 serving the director with a copy of the affidavit. The circuit
- 18 court of the county in which the complainant resides shall have
- 19 jurisdiction to hear and determine the questions of fact or law
- 20 involved in the appeal.
- 21 (9) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (3) AND SECTIONS 5 AND 7(2) OF
- 22 THE CHILD PROTECTION LAW, 1975 PA 238, MCL 722.625 AND 722.627,
- 23 INFORMATION OR RECORDS IN THE POSSESSION OF THE DEPARTMENT OR THE
- 24 DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS MAY BE SHARED TO THE
- 25 EXTENT NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER FUNCTIONING OF THE DEPARTMENT OR
- 26 THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS IN ADMINISTERING
- 27 ADULT WELFARE OR ADULT FOSTER CARE LICENSING UNDER THIS ACT OR IN

- AN INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED UNDER SECTION 43B OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE 1
- 2 ACT, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.43B. INFORMATION OR RECORDS SHARED UNDER
- THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT BE RELEASED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR THE 3
- DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS UNLESS OTHERWISE
- PERMITTED UNDER THIS ACT OR OTHER STATE OR FEDERAL LAW. 5
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 6
- 7 after the date it is enacted into law.
