## **HOUSE BILL No. 4161**

February 5, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Hughes, Johnson, Chatfield, Cox, Hooker, Goike, Yonker, Glardon, Outman, Bizon, Runestad, Canfield, Kelly, Webber, Glenn, Maturen, Kivela and Derek Miller and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 222 (MCL 750.222), as amended by 2012 PA 242.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 222. As used in this chapter:
- 2 (a) "Alcoholic liquor" means that term as defined in section
- 3 105 of the Michigan liquor control code of 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL
- 4 436.1105.
  - (b) "Barrel length" means the internal length of a firearm as measured from the face of the closed breech of the firearm when it is unloaded, to the forward face of the end of the barrel.
  - (C) "BRANDISH" MEANS TO INTENTIONALLY POINT, WAVE ABOUT, OR DISPLAY IN A THREATENING MANNER THAT WOULD INDUCE FEAR IN A REASONABLE PERSON.
    - (D)  $\frac{(c)}{(c)}$  "Controlled substance" means a controlled substance or

- 1 controlled substance analogue as those terms are defined in section

- **3 (E) (d)** "Firearm" means a weapon from which a dangerous
- 4 projectile may be propelled by an explosive, or by gas or air.
- 5 Firearm does not include a smooth bore rifle or handqun designed
- 6 and manufactured exclusively for propelling by a spring, or by gas
- 7 or air, BBs not exceeding .177 caliber.
- 8 (F) (e) "Pistol" means a loaded or unloaded firearm that is 26
- 9 inches or less in length, or a loaded or unloaded firearm that by
- 10 its construction and appearance conceals itself as a firearm.
- 11 (G) (f) "Purchaser" means a person who receives a pistol from
- 12 another person by purchase, gift, or loan.
- 13 (H) "RIFLE" MEANS A FIREARM DESIGNED OR REDESIGNED, MADE OR
- 14 REMADE, AND INTENDED TO BE FIRED FROM THE SHOULDER AND DESIGNED OR
- 15 REDESIGNED AND MADE OR REMADE TO USE THE ENERGY OF THE EXPLOSIVE IN
- 16 A FIXED METALLIC CARTRIDGE TO FIRE ONLY A SINGLE PROJECTILE THROUGH
- 17 A RIFLED BORE FOR EACH SINGLE PULL OF THE TRIGGER.
- (I) <del>(g)</del> "Seller" means a person who sells, furnishes, loans,

- 20 (J) (h)—"Shotqun" means a firearm designed or redesigned, made
- 21 or remade, and intended to be fired from the shoulder and designed

- 3 (j) "Rifle" means a firearm designed or redesigned, made or

- 5 redesigned and made or remade to use the energy of the explosive in
- 6 a fixed metallic cartridge to fire only a single projectile through
- 7 a rifled bore for each single pull of the trigger.
- 8 (l) (k)—"Short-barreled rifle" means a rifle having 1 or more
- 9 barrels less than 16 inches in length or a weapon made from a
- 10 rifle, whether by alteration, modification, or otherwise, if the
- 11 weapon as modified has an overall length of less than 26 inches.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 13 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 14 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 15 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 4160 (request no.
- 16 01269'15) of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
