THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 18. (1) Any EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (4), ANY
 rights in and to vested pension, annuity, or retirement benefits,
 or accumulated contributions in any pension, annuity, or retirement
 system, payable to or on behalf of a party on account of service
 credit accrued by the party during marriage shall be considered
 part of the marital estate subject to award by the court under this
 chapter.
 - (2) Any EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (4), ANY rights or contingent rights in and to unvested pension, annuity, or retirement benefits payable to or on behalf of a party on account

- 20 CHILDREN. A VETERAN SHALL DISCLOSE TO THE COURT ANY COMPENSATION
- 21 RECEIVED FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OR
- 22 VETERANS ADMINISTRATION FOR THE SUPPORT OF HIS OR HER DEPENDENTS.
