A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"
by amending the heading of part 58 and sections 5801, 5805, 5815, 5817, 5821, 5823, 5825, 5828, 5831, 5835, 5841, 5843, 5847, 5863, 5871, 5874, and 5879 (MCL 333.5801, 333.5805, 333.5815, 333.5817, 333.5821, 333.5823, 333.5825, 333.5828, 333.5831, 333.5835,

333.5841, 333.5843, 333.5847, 333.5863, 333.5871, 333.5874, and 333.5879), section 5805 as amended by 1988 PA 236 and section 5817 as amended by 1998 PA 88; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

PART 58

CRIPPLED CHILDREN AND YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS

Sec. 5801. (1) As used in this part, "crippled "child OR YOUTH

WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS" or "child" means a single or

married individual under 21 years of age whose activity is or may

- 1 become so restricted by disease or deformity as to reduce the
- 2 individual's normal capacity for education and self-support.
- 3 (2) In addition, article 1 contains general definitions and
- 4 principles of construction applicable to all articles in this code
- 5 and part 51 contains definitions applicable to this part.
- 6 Sec. 5805. (1) The department shall develop, extend, and
- 7 improve services FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- 8 (a) For locating crippled children and children suffering from
- 9 conditions which lead to crippling and, effective April 1, 1989,
- 10 for locating children TO LOCATE A CHILD OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL
- 11 HEALTH CARE NEEDS reported to the department pursuant to section
- **12** 5721.
- 13 (b) For providing TO PROVIDE medical, surgical, corrective,
- 14 nutritional, and other services and care, including aftercare when
- 15 IF necessary, and TO PROVIDE facilities for diagnosis DIAGNOSING
- 16 and hospitalization of crippled children. HOSPITALIZING A CHILD OR
- 17 YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS.
- 18 (c) For preventing, insofar as TO THE EXTENT possible,
- 19 crippling conditions. TO PREVENT DISEASES AND DEFORMITIES THAT
- 20 REDUCE AN INDIVIDUAL'S NORMAL CAPACITY FOR EDUCATION AND SELF-
- 21 SUPPORT.
- 22 (2) The department shall refer children A CHILD reported to
- 23 the department pursuant to UNDER section 5721 who are IS in need of
- 24 services to the appropriate services inside or outside of the
- 25 department.
- 26 (3) The **DEPARTMENT SHALL CARRY OUT THE** program shall be
- 27 carried out ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 5815 for the purposes of

- 1 providing medical and physical care for crippled children and for
- 2 making them self-sustaining in whole or in part rather than
- 3 dependent on the public for support.CARE AND TREATMENT TO IMPROVE
- 4 OR MAINTAIN HEALTH AND ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR CHILDREN AND
- 5 YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS.
- 6 Sec. 5815. The department shall establish and administer a
- 7 program of services for crippled-children AND YOUTH WITH SPECIAL
- 8 HEALTH CARE NEEDS and children who are suffering from conditions
- 9 which lead to crippling. SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS BECAUSE OF
- 10 DISEASE OR DEFORMITY. In implementing this part, the department
- 11 shall promulgate rules THAT DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 12 (a) To prescribe requirements for the approval of facilities
- 13 and treatment centers, medical and surgical specialists, and other
- 14 providers.
- 15 (b) To regulate the conduct of clinics; handling of cases;
- 16 fixing of treatment fees, charges for correctional equipment, and
- 17 institutional rates; and prescribing procedures for audit and
- 18 payment of bills.
- 19 (A) PROVIDE FOR THE MONITORING OF THE AVAILABILITY AND QUALITY
- 20 OF FACILITIES, TREATMENT CENTERS, MEDICAL AND SURGICAL SPECIALISTS,
- 21 AND OTHER PROVIDERS FOR CHILDREN OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE
- 22 NEEDS.
- 23 (B) (c) To implement IMPLEMENT section 5841.
- 24 Sec. 5817. The department shall DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 25 (a) Formulate and administer detailed plans POLICIES to
- 26 implement the policy PROGRAM SERVICES stated in section 5805. The
- 27 plans DEPARTMENT shall include provisions for:ALL OF THE FOLLOWING

- 1 IN THE POLICIES UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION:
- 2 (i) Financial participation by this state.
- 3 (ii) Administration of the plans including methods of
- 4 administration necessary for efficient operation of the
- 5 plans.POLICIES.
- 6 (iii) Maintenance of records and preparation of reports of
- 7 services rendered.
- 8 (iv) Cooperation with medical, health, nursing, and welfare
- 9 groups and organizations, HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ORGANIZATIONS
- 10 and with any agency of this state charged with the administration
- 11 of laws providing for vocational rehabilitation and special
- 12 education of children AND YOUTH with physical disabilities.SPECIAL
- 13 HEALTH CARE NEEDS.
- 14 (b) Expend in accordance with the plans funds MONEY made
- 15 available to this state by the federal government for those
- 16 purposes.
- 17 (C) DEVELOP SYSTEMS OF CARE THAT ARE COMMUNITY BASED,
- 18 COMPREHENSIVE, CULTURALLY COMPETENT, COORDINATED, AND FAMILY
- 19 CENTERED.
- 20 (D) (c) Cooperate with the federal government, under title V
- 21 of the social security act, chapter 531, 49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C.
- 22 USC 701 to 716, 713, through its appropriate agency or
- 23 instrumentality, in developing, extending, and improving services,
- 24 provided by this part and in the administration of the plans.
- Sec. 5821. (1) The department shall provide for diagnostic
- 26 clinics for crippled children AND YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE
- 27 NEEDS in places, at times, and under circumstances it determines.

- 1 The department may purchase diagnostic services from outpatient
- 2 departments of approved hospitals and other facilities.
- 3 (2) Results THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE RESULTS of examinations
- 4 at clinics shall be available to parents and individuals and
- 5 agencies providing social and remedial services to erippled
- 6 children AND YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS where they are
- 7 residents, unless otherwise prohibited by law.
- 8 Sec. 5823. When IF a crippled child OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL
- 9 HEALTH CARE NEEDS is found whose condition can be treated and whose
- 10 parent or spouse is unable to provide proper care and treatment,
- 11 IDENTIFIED, a person authorized by rule shall MAY apply to a
- 12 designated representative of the department for eligibility for
- 13 services under this part. The representative DEPARTMENT shall make
- 14 a financial investigation DETERMINATION and secure medical evidence
- 15 as to the condition of the child. A copy of the report of the
- 16 financial investigation and the report of a physician or dentist,
- 17 if any, shall be sent to the department.
- 18 Sec. 5825. Upon receipt—COMPLETION of the financial and
- 19 medical reports, DETERMINATIONS UNDER SECTION 5823, the department
- 20 shall promptly consider the matter and make a determination of
- 21 eligibility. The department shall authorize the transportation of
- 22 an eligible crippled child **OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS**
- 23 to a provider of services approved and designated by the
- 24 department. The department shall monitor the proper handling of the
- 25 case and may transfer the crippled IN CONSULTATION WITH THE FAMILY,
- 26 THE DEPARTMENT MAY FACILITATE TRANSFER OF A child OR YOUTH WITH
- 27 SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS to some other A provider for treatment

- 1 better adapted to the child's needs. In making referrals under this
- 2 part the department shall not discriminate against health
- 3 professionals qualified to render care.
- 4 Sec. 5828. The administrator of a hospital shall provide a bed
- 5 in the hospital to which a crippled child shall be OR YOUTH WITH
- 6 SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS IS assigned for operation or treatment,
- 7 or both, of the child's disease or deformity. The physician or
- 8 surgeon approved by the department shall proceed as promptly as
- 9 necessary to perform or give a necessary operation or treatment.
- 10 Sec. 5831. (1) An approved hospital receiving crippled
- 11 children A CHILD OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS shall send
- 12 to the department A written reports REPORT on forms A FORM
- 13 furnished by the department which shall contain dates THAT CONTAINS
- 14 THE DATE of admission and discharge, THE names of approved
- 15 physicians and surgeons, and other information the department
- 16 requires.
- 17 (2) The times TIME for making the reports shall REPORT UNDER
- 18 SUBSECTION (1) MUST conform to applicable state and federal
- 19 requirements.
- 20 Sec. 5835. (1) An approved hospital shall arrange with the
- 21 local school district in which a child resides to provide or
- 22 contract for educational services for a convalescent crippled
- 23 child. UPON RECEIVING THE PARENT'S CONSENT, AN APPROVED HOSPITAL
- 24 SHALL ARRANGE WITH THE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT IN WHICH A CHILD
- 25 RESIDES TO PROVIDE OR CONTRACT FOR EDUCATIONAL SERVICES FOR THE
- 26 HOSPITALIZED CHILD.
- 27 (2) Courses of study, attendance record systems, adequacy of

- 1 methods of instruction, qualifications of teachers and conditions
- 2 under which they are employed, and purchases of necessary equipment
- 3 for the instruction of crippled children in the hospital shall A
- 4 HOSPITALIZED CHILD OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS MUST
- 5 comply with requirements prescribed by the department of education.
- 6 (3) A hospital shall keep daily records on the regular child
- 7 accounting forms used in the public schools, listing all children
- 8 actually receiving instruction.
- 9 Sec. 5841. (1) All or part of the charges for the MEDICAL care
- 10 and treatment of a crippled-child where-OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL
- 11 HEALTH CARE NEEDS MUST BE PAID TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY BY the
- 12 child, parent, or spouse, is of sufficient IF THAT INDIVIDUAL HAS
- 13 THE ability to pay. shall be paid to the department of treasury by
- 14 those persons THE PAYMENT MUST BE in the amount and at a rate
- 15 determined by agreement with BETWEEN THE INDIVIDUAL AND the
- 16 department. Upon admission to service TREATMENT of the crippled
- 17 child OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS, the department of
- 18 public-COMMUNITY health shall furnish the department of treasury
- 19 information required to keep a correct account of the money due the
- 20 THIS state from the child, parent, or spouse. Payment of the costs
- 21 by the child, parent, or spouse shall be made to the department of
- 22 treasury in accordance with the agreement. The department of
- 23 treasury shall credit the payments to the crippled children's
- 24 CHILDREN AND YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS fund.
- 25 (2) The department may modify or cancel an agreement made
- 26 under this section based on economic or other factors and shall
- 27 report that action to the department of treasury.

- 1 (3) The department of treasury may accept and issue a receipt
- 2 for an amount due under an agreement or modification TO AN
- 3 AGREEMENT under this section.
- 4 Sec. 5843. This state shall be IS subrogated to the rights of
- 5 recovery which THAT a child, parent, spouse, or guardian may have
- 6 against a liable third party for the cost of care and surgical and
- 7 medical treatment provided for TO a crippled child OR YOUTH WITH
- 8 SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS under this part to the extent that the
- 9 state has spent moneys MONEY for that care and treatment.
- 10 Sec. 5847. Payments made by the THIS state pursuant to UNDER
- 11 this part are not considered social services aid, and an individual
- 12 is not considered an indigent because of HIS OR HER inability to
- 13 pay for the care and treatment of a crippled child OR YOUTH WITH
- 14 SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS.
- 15 Sec. 5863. The department of treasury shall DO ALL OF THE
- 16 FOLLOWING:
- 17 (a) Receive money granted to this state by the federal
- 18 government under this part.
- 19 (b) Keep the money in a special fund to be known as the
- 20 "crippled children's "CHILDREN AND YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE
- 21 NEEDS fund".
- (c) Disburse MONEY FROM the fund on certification by the
- 23 department of public COMMUNITY health.
- 24 Sec. 5871. (1) A department official, agent, or representative
- 25 shall not enter a home or take charge of a crippled child OR YOUTH
- 26 WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS over the objection of a parent, the
- 27 A GUARDIAN, A person standing in loco parentis, or the person

- 1 having THAT HAS custody of the child.
- 2 (2) This part does not limit the power of a parent, guardian,
- 3 or person standing in loco parentis OF THE CHILD to accept or
- 4 refuse the treatment SERVICES offered under this part for a
- 5 crippled child OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS or by an
- 6 agency employed for that purpose.
- 7 Sec. 5874. Records as to crippled children REGARDING A CHILD
- 8 OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS are confidential to the
- 9 extent required by state and federal statutes and rules. Disclosure
- 10 PART 26 APPLIES TO THE DISCLOSURE of information shall be
- 11 consistent with part 26.REGARDING A CHILD OR YOUTH WITH SPECIAL
- 12 HEALTH CARE NEEDS UNDER THIS PART.
- Sec. 5879. (1) A person who wilfully makes a false statement
- 14 or wilfully gives false information for the purpose of securing aid
- 15 under this part is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 16 (2) An official of a hospital or a physician or dentist who
- 17 bills the THIS state for the care of a crippled child OR YOUTH WITH
- 18 SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS in accordance with the fee schedules
- 19 established under this part and WHO also attempts to force a
- 20 parent, relative, or guardian of the child to pay an additional sum
- 21 for the care is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 22 Enacting section 1. Section 5811 of the public health code,
- 23 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.5811, is repealed.
