A bill to amend 1979 PA 218, entitled

"Adult foster care facility licensing act,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 400.703), as amended by 2014 PA 450.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) "Adult" means:
- 2 (a) A person 18 years of age or older.
- (b) A person who is placed in an adult foster care family home
 or an adult foster care small group home pursuant to UNDER section
 5 (6) or (8) of 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.115.
 - (2) "Adult foster care camp" or "adult camp" means an adult foster care facility with the approved capacity to receive more than 4 adults to be provided foster care. An adult foster care camp is a facility located in a natural or rural environment.
 - (3) "Adult foster care congregate facility" means an adult foster care facility with the approved capacity to receive more

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- 1 than 20 adults to be provided with foster care.
- 2 (4) "Adult foster care facility" means a governmental or
- 3 nongovernmental establishment that provides foster care to adults.
- 4 Subject to section 26a(1), adult foster care facility includes
- 5 facilities and foster care family homes for THAT PROVIDE 1 OR MORE
- 6 ELEMENTS OF FOSTER CARE TO adults who are aged, mentally ill,
- 7 developmentally disabled, or physically disabled who require
- 8 supervision on an ongoing basis but who do not require continuous
- 9 nursing care. Adult foster care facility does not include any of
- 10 the following:
- 11 (a) A nursing home licensed under article 17 of the public
- 12 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20101 to 333.22260.
- 13 (b) A home for the aged licensed under article 17 of the
- 14 public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20101 to 333.22260.
- 15 (c) A hospital licensed under article 17 of the public health
- 16 code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20101 to 333.22260.
- 17 (d) A hospital for the mentally ill or a facility for the
- 18 developmentally disabled operated by the department of community
- 19 health AND HUMAN SERVICES under the mental health code, 1974 PA
- 20 258, MCL 330.1001 to 330.2106.
- 21 (e) A county infirmary operated by a county department of
- 22 social services or family independence agency HEALTH AND HUMAN
- 23 SERVICES under section 55 of the social welfare act, 1939 PA 280,
- 24 MCL 400.55.
- 25 (f) A child caring institution, children's camp, foster family
- 26 home, or foster family group home licensed or approved under 1973
- 27 PA 116, MCL 722.111 to 722.128, if the number of residents who

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- 1 become 18 years of age while residing in the institution, camp, or
- 2 home does not exceed the following:
- 3 (i) Two, if the total number of residents is 10 or fewer.
- 4 (ii) Three, if the total number of residents is not less than
- 5 11 and not more than 14.
- 6 (iii) Four, if the total number of residents is not less than 15
- 7 and not more than 20.
- 8 (iv) Five, if the total number of residents is 21 or more.
- 9 (g) A foster family home licensed or approved under 1973 PA
- 10 116, MCL 722.111 to 722.128, that has a person who is 18 years of
- 11 age or older placed in the foster family home under section 5(7) of
- 12 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.115.
- 13 (h) An establishment commonly described as an alcohol or a
- 14 substance abuse USE DISORDER rehabilitation center, a residential
- 15 facility for persons released from or assigned to adult
- 16 correctional institutions, a maternity home, or a hotel or rooming
- 17 house that does not provide or offer to provide foster care.
- 18 (i) A facility created by 1885 PA 152, MCL 36.1 to 36.12.
- 19 (j) An area excluded from the definition of adult foster care
- 20 facility under section 17(3) of the continuing care community
- 21 disclosure act, 2014 PA 448, MCL 554.917.
- 22 (5) "Adult foster care family home" means a private residence
- 23 with the approved capacity to receive 6 or fewer adults to be
- 24 provided with foster care for 5 or more days a week and for 2 or
- 25 more consecutive weeks. The adult foster care family home licensee
- 26 shall be a member of the household, and an occupant of the
- 27 residence.

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- 1 (6) "Adult foster care large group home" means an adult foster
- 2 care facility with the approved capacity to receive at least 13 but
- 3 not more than 20 adults to be provided with foster care.
- 4 (7) "Adult foster care small group home" means an adult foster
- 5 care facility with the approved capacity to receive 12 or fewer
- 6 adults to be provided with foster care.
- 7 (8) "Aged" means an adult whose chronological age is 60 years
- 8 of age or older or whose biological age, as determined by a
- 9 physician, is 60 years of age or older.
- 10 (9) "Assessment plan" means a written statement prepared in
- 11 cooperation with a responsible agency or person that identifies the
- 12 specific care and maintenance, services, and resident activities
- 13 appropriate for each individual resident's physical and behavioral
- 14 needs and well-being and the methods of providing the care and
- 15 services taking into account the preferences and competency of the
- 16 individual.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
