A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled  
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"  
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 914a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1           SEC. 914A. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2),  
2   A PERSON SHALL NOT USE OR OFFER FOR USE, POSSESS, SELL, OR OFFER  
3   FOR SALE POWDERED ALCOHOL. A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS  
4   GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 909.

5           (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A HOSPITAL THAT OPERATES  
6   PRIMARILY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH, A  
7   STATE INSTITUTION CONDUCTING BONA FIDE RESEARCH, A PRIVATE COLLEGE  
8   OR UNIVERSITY CONDUCTING BONA FIDE RESEARCH, OR A PHARMACEUTICAL  
9   COMPANY OR BIOTECHNOLOGY COMPANY CONDUCTING BONA FIDE RESEARCH.

10          (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "POWDERED ALCOHOL" MEANS ALCOHOL  
11   THAT IS SOLD IN POWDER FORM FOR EITHER DIRECT USE OR

1   **RECONSTITUTION.**

2           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
3   after the date it is enacted into law.
