

# HOUSE BILL No. 4500

April 22, 2015, Introduced by Rep. Runestad and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 2004 PA 452, entitled  
"Identity theft protection act,"  
(MCL 445.61 to 445.79c) by adding section 79d.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 79D. (1) BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 2016, EACH REPORTING  
2        AGENCY SHALL REPORT ALL SEIZURE AND FORFEITURE ACTIVITIES UNDER  
3        THIS ACT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE AS REQUIRED UNDER THE  
4        UNIFORM FORFEITURE REPORTING ACT.

5        (2) BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 2016, EACH REPORTING AGENCY IS  
6        SUBJECT TO AUDIT AS REQUIRED UNDER THE UNIFORM FORFEITURE REPORTING  
7        ACT.

8        (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "REPORTING AGENCY" MEANS THAT  
9        TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 7 OF THE UNIFORM FORFEITURE REPORTING  
10       ACT.

11       Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

1 after the date it is enacted into law.

2 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
3 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 4504 (request no.  
4 02301'15) of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
