THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 280. (1) BEFORE SEEKING APPROVAL FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE
- 2 COMMISSION FOR PRIVATIZING ANY SERVICES THAT REPLACE SERVICES
- 3 PERFORMED BY STATE EMPLOYEES, A STATE AGENCY SHALL SUBMIT A
- 4 DETAILED PREPRIVATIZATION COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS TO THE
- 5 APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF
- 6 REPRESENTATIVES. THE ANALYSIS SHALL BE PREPARED UTILIZING ACCURATE,
- 7 RELIABLE, AND OBJECTIVE DATA AND SHALL USE THE SOUNDEST ACTUARIAL
- 8 TECHNIQUES THAT ARE AVAILABLE TO THE STATE AGENCY. THE ANALYSIS
