A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 636 (MCL 257.636).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 636. (1) The following rules shall govern the overtaking
- 2 and passing of vehicles proceeding in the same direction, subject
- 3 to those limitations, exceptions, and special rules stated in
- 4 sections 637 to 643a:
 - (a) The driver of a vehicle overtaking another vehicle proceeding in the same direction shall pass at a safe distance to the left of that vehicle, and when safely clear of the overtaken vehicle shall take up a position as near the right-hand edge of the main traveled portion of the highway as is practicable.
 - (B) UPON A ROADWAY HAVING 2 OR MORE LANES FOR TRAVEL IN 1 DIRECTION, THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE IN THE EXTREME LEFT-HAND LANE

- 1 SHALL NOT CONTINUE TO OPERATE HIS OR HER VEHICLE IN THAT LANE IF HE
