A bill to amend 1956 PA 217, entitled "Electrical administrative act," by amending section 3e (MCL 338.883e), as added by 1990 PA 246.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3e. (1) An individual WHO IS employed as an apprentice 2 electrician shall register with the board on a form provided by the 3 board within 30 days after employment.
- 4 (2) The department of labor LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS shall issue a certificate of registration to a person AN INDIVIDUAL 5
- WHO IS seeking registration upon IF IT RECEIVES satisfactory proof

of the person's INDIVIDUAL'S participation in a bona fide AN
