A bill to amend 2014 PA 276, entitled "Methamphetamine abuse reporting act," by amending section 4 (MCL 28.124).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 4. (1) The information provided to NADDI under this
 section shall be for the purpose of generating a stop-sale alert
 through NPLEx for individuals who have been convicted of
 methamphetamine-related offenses. The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
 SUBSECTION (2), THE stop-sale alert applies until the expiration of
 10 years after the individual is convicted of the methamphetaminerelated offense.
 - (2) THE STOP-SALE ALERT APPLIES UNTIL THE EXPIRATION OF 5
 YEARS AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL IS CONVICTED OF VIOLATING SECTION
 7430C(3) OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7430C.
