

# HOUSE BILL No. 4889

September 22, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Goike, Runestad, Santana, Chatfield, Outman, Robinson, Hooker, Heise, Dianda, Inman, Lauwers and Yanez and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 267, entitled  
"Open meetings act,"  
by amending section 2 (MCL 15.262), as amended by 2001 PA 38.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2       (a) "Public body" means any state or local legislative or  
3 governing body, including a board, commission, committee,  
4 subcommittee, authority, or council, that is empowered by state  
5 constitution, statute, charter, ordinance, resolution, or rule to  
6 exercise governmental or proprietary authority or perform a  
7 governmental or proprietary function; a lessee of such a body  
8 performing an essential public purpose and function pursuant to the  
9 lease agreement; ~~or~~ the board of a nonprofit corporation formed by  
10 a city under section 40 of the home rule city act, 1909 PA 279, MCL  
11 117.40; OR THE BOARD OF AN ART INSTITUTE SERVICES PROVIDER THAT HAS

1 ENTERED INTO A CONTRACT WITH AN ART INSTITUTE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE  
2 ART INSTITUTE SERVICES AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION 3 OF  
3 THE ART INSTITUTE AUTHORITIES ACT, 2010 PA 296, MCL 123.1203.

4 (b) "Meeting" means the convening of a public body at which a  
5 quorum is present for the purpose of deliberating toward or  
6 rendering a decision on a public policy; ~~or any meeting of the~~  
7 board of a nonprofit corporation formed by a city under section 40  
8 of the home rule city act, 1909 PA 279, MCL 117.40; **OR ANY MEETING**  
9 **OF THE BOARD OF AN ART INSTITUTE SERVICES PROVIDER THAT IS A PUBLIC**  
10 **BODY.**

11 (c) "Closed session" means a meeting or part of a meeting of a  
12 public body that is closed to the public.

13 (d) "Decision" means a determination, action, vote, or  
14 disposition upon a motion, proposal, recommendation, resolution,  
15 order, ordinance, bill, or measure on which a vote by members of a  
16 public body is required and by which a public body effectuates or  
17 formulates public policy.

18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
19 after the date it is enacted into law.
