## **HOUSE BILL No. 4924**

September 29, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Poleski and Chirkun and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending section 2559 (MCL 600.2559), as amended by 2012 PA 558.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2559. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (8),
- 2 the following is the schedule of fees allowed for process or papers
- 3 served out of a court in this state by a person authorized under
- 4 this act or supreme court rule to serve process:
  - (a) For personal service of a summons and complaint in a civil action, along with supporting documents, for each defendant, \$23.00 \$25.00 plus mileage.
  - (b) For personal service of an affidavit and account, for each defendant, \$23.00 \$25.00 plus mileage.

- 1 (c) For a request for and writ of garnishment, for each
- 2 garnishee and defendant, \$20.00 \$22.00 plus mileage.
- 3 (d) For personal service of an order to seize goods that are
- 4 the subject of a claim and delivery action, \$37.00 \$39.00 plus
- 5 mileage, plus the actual and reasonable expense of seizing,
- 6 keeping, and delivering the goods.
- 7 (e) For receiving and filing a bond from or on behalf of a
- 8 defendant in a claim and delivery action, \$17.00.\$19.00.
- 9 (f) For an order to show cause, for each person served, \$23.00
- 10 \$25.00 plus mileage.
- 11 (g) For a subpoena on discovery, for each person served,
- 12 \$23.00 \$25.00 plus mileage.
- 13 (h) For levying under or serving an order for the seizure of
- 14 property and any accompanying paper, \$37.00 \$39.00 plus mileage,
- 15 plus the actual and reasonable expense of seizing and keeping the
- 16 property under the order.
- 17 (i) If the person has seized property under an order for the
- 18 seizure of property issued in an action in which a judgment is
- 19 entered against the owner of the property, regardless of whether
- 20 the judgment is entered before or after the order is issued, and if
- 21 the judgment is satisfied prior to BEFORE sale of the seized
- 22 property by full payment of the judgment or settlement between the
- 23 parties, 7% of the first \$8,000.00 of the payment or settlement
- 24 amount and 3% of the payment or settlement amount exceeding the
- 25 first \$8,000.00.
- 26 (j) For sale of property seized under an order for the seizure
- 27 of property, 7% of the first \$8,000.00 in receipts and 3% of any

- 1 receipts exceeding the first \$8,000.00.
- 2 (k) For each notice of sale under an order for the seizure of
- 3 property or construction lien posted in a public place in the city
- 4 or township, \$23.00 \$25.00 plus mileage.
- 5 (1) For an order of eviction or a writ for the restitution of
- 6 premises, for each defendant, \$37.00 \$39.00 plus mileage, plus the
- 7 actual and reasonable expense for the physical removal of property
- 8 from the premises.
- 9 (m) For a subpoena directed to a witness, including a judgment
- 10 debtor, \$23.00 \$25.00 plus mileage.
- (n) For a civil bench warrant or body execution, \$37.00 \$39.00
- 12 plus mileage, plus a reasonable fee per hour for the amount of time
- 13 involved in executing the warrant.
- 14 (o) For service by mail, \$10.00 \$12.00 plus the actual cost of
- 15 postage.
- 16 (p) For each verification by a process server, \$10.00 plus
- 17 mileage.
- 18 (q) For each postal change of address verification requested
- 19 by the plaintiff, \$10.00.
- 20 (R) FOR EACH GLOBAL POSITIONING SERVICE VERIFICATION REQUESTED
- 21 BY THE PLAINTIFF, \$10.00.
- 22 (S) FOR EACH PHOTO VERIFICATION REQUESTED BY THE PLAINTIFF,
- 23 \$10.00.
- 24 (2) Each of the fees prescribed in subsection (1)(a) to (0)
- 25 shall increase (H) AND (K) TO (S) INCREASES by \$1.00 on October 1,
- 26 2013, \$1.00 on October 1, 2014, and \$1.00 on October 1, 2015.
- 27 (3) Upon submitting a sworn affidavit, a person authorized by

- 1 this act or supreme court rule to serve process or papers out of a
- 2 court in this state is entitled to receive a \$10.00 \$15.00 fee plus
- 3 mileage for each process that has an incorrect address. This fee is
- 4 in addition to any fee the person is entitled to receive under
- 5 subsection (1).
- 6 (4) Mileage IS allowed under subsection (1) shall be AT 1-1/2
- 7 times the rate allowed by the state civil service commission for
- 8 employees in the state classified civil service. Mileage shall be
- 9 IS computed, each way, using the shortest reasonable route from the
- 10 place where the court that issued or filed the process or paper is
- 11 located to the place of service.
- 12 (5) The fees and expenses allowed under subsection (1)(h) to
- 13 (k) shall MUST be collected in the same manner as the sum directed
- 14 to be levied or collected under the order for the seizure of
- 15 property. If at the time of advertising property for sale a sheriff
- 16 or other officer has several orders for the seizure of property
- 17 against the same defendant, THE SHERIFF OR OFFICER SHALL CHARGE
- 18 only 1 advertising fee shall be charged on the whole, and the
- 19 sheriff or other officer shall elect upon ON which order he or she
- 20 will receive that THE fee.
- 21 (6) A person authorized by this act or supreme court rule to
- 22 serve process or papers out of a court in this state who demands
- 23 and receives a greater fee or compensation for performing a service
- 24 mentioned in this section than allowed by this section is, in
- 25 addition to all other liability provided by law, liable to the
- 26 party injured by paying the illegal fees for 3 times the amount of
- 27 illegal fees actually paid and all costs of the action.

- 1 (7) A sheriff or other officer who, after the fees specified
- 2 by this section have been tendered, neglects or refuses a service
- 3 required by law is liable to the party injured for all damages that
- 4 the party sustains as a result of that THE neglect or refusal.
- 5 (8) A person authorized under this act or supreme court rule
- 6 to serve process may charge a fee for service of process that
- 7 exceeds the fee prescribed under this section or other law if the
- 8 fee is agreed to in advance in writing by the person serving
- 9 process and the person requesting the service.
- 10 (9) Regardless of whether a fee charged or paid for service of
- 11 process exceeds the fee prescribed by this section or other law,
- 12 including a fee allowed under subsection (8), a person entitled to
- 13 tax costs shall not attempt to tax and is not entitled to recover a
- 14 fee for service of process that exceeds the fee prescribed by this
- 15 section or other law.
- 16 (10) As used in this section, "order for the seizure of
- 17 property" includes a writ of attachment and a writ of execution,
- 18 including, but not limited to, execution in a claim and delivery
- 19 action on property other than the property that is the subject of
- 20 the claim and delivery action.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
