1 CHAPTER 19A

- 2 SEC. 1986. (1) IF A FEE FOR COMMENCING A CIVIL ACTION IS
- 3 AUTHORIZED OR REQUIRED BY LAW, IN ADDITION TO THAT FEE, THE CLERK
