## **HOUSE BILL No. 5146**

December 10, 2015, Introduced by Rep. Kivela and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 40118 (MCL 324.40118), as amended by 2012 PA 520.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 40118. (1) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates this part, an order or interim order issued under this part, or a condition of a permit issued under this part, except for a violation specified in subsections (2) to (12), (13), is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or a fine of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$500.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution. In addition, a permit issued by the department

- 1 under this part shall be revoked pursuant to the administrative
- 2 procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328.
- 3 (2) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates a provision of this
- 4 part or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding
- 5 the possession or taking of any game, except deer, bear, wild
- 6 turkey, wolf, moose, or elk, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable
- 7 by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or a fine of not less
- 8 than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both, and the costs of
- 9 prosecution.
- 10 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a person
- 11 AN INDIVIDUAL who violates a provision of this part or an order or
- 12 interim order issued under this part regarding the possession or
- 13 taking of deer, bear, wild turkey, or wolf is guilty of a
- 14 misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than
- 15 5 days or more than 90 days, and a fine of not less than \$200.00 or
- 16 more than \$1,000.00, and the costs of prosecution. A person AN
- 17 INDIVIDUAL shall not be punished under this subsection for lawfully
- 18 removing, capturing, or destroying a wolf under 2008 PA 290, MCL
- 19 324.95151 to 324.95155, or 2008 PA 318, MCL 324.95161 to 324.95167.
- 20 (4) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates a provision of this
- 21 part or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding
- 22 the possession or taking of elk is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 23 punishable by imprisonment for not less than 30 days or more than
- 24 180 days, or a fine of not less than \$500.00 or more than
- \$2,000.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution.
- 26 (5) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates a provision of this
- 27 part or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding

- 1 the possession or taking of moose is guilty of a misdemeanor and
- 2 shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than 90 days or more
- 3 than 1 year and a fine of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than
- 4 \$5,000.00, and the costs of prosecution.
- 5 (6) A person AN INDIVIDUAL sentenced pursuant to UNDER
- 6 subsection (3), (4), (5), (10), or (11) shall not secure or possess
- 7 a license of any kind to hunt during the remainder of the year in
- 8 which convicted and the next 3 succeeding calendar years. A person
- 9 AN INDIVIDUAL sentenced pursuant to UNDER subsection (7) shall not
- 10 secure or possess a license to hunt during the remainder of the
- 11 year in which convicted and the next succeeding calendar year.
- 12 (7) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates section 40113(1) is
- 13 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not less
- 14 than 5 days or more than 90 days, or a fine of not less than
- 15 \$100.00 or more than \$500.00, or both, and the costs of
- 16 prosecution.
- 17 (8) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates section 40113(2) is
- 18 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more
- 19 than 90 days, or a fine of not less than \$50.00 or more than
- 20 \$500.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution.
- 21 (9) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates section 40113(3) is
- 22 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for
- 23 not less than 5 days or more than 90 days and a fine of not less
- 24 than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00, and the costs of prosecution.
- 25 (10) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who violates a provision of this
- 26 part or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding
- 27 the taking or possession of an animal that has been designated by

- 1 the department to be a protected animal, other than an animal that
- 2 appears on a list prepared pursuant to UNDER section 36505, is
- 3 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more
- 4 than 90 days or a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than
- 5 \$1,000.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution.
- **6** (11) <del>A person **AN INDIVIDUAL** who buys or sells game or a</del>
- 7 protected animal in violation of this part or an order or interim
- 8 order issued under this part is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable
- 9 by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not more
- 10 than \$1,000.00, or both, for the first offense, and is guilty of a
- 11 felony for each subsequent offense.
- 12 (12) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES A PROVISION OF THIS PART OR AN
- 13 ORDER OR INTERIM ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS PART REGARDING THE
- 14 IMPORTATION OF DEER OR ELK CARCASSES FROM A STATE OR PROVINCE
- 15 DETECTED TO HAVE CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE IN FREE-RANGING DEER OR
- 16 ELK POPULATIONS IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY
- 17 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN
- 18 \$500.00 OR MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH, AND THE COSTS OF
- 19 PROSECUTION.
- 20 (13) (12)—If a person—AN INDIVIDUAL is convicted of a
- 21 violation of this part or an order or interim order issued under
- 22 this part and it is alleged in the complaint and proved or admitted
- 23 at trial or ascertained by the court after conviction that the
- 24 person INDIVIDUAL had been previously convicted 2 times within the
- 25 preceding 5 years for a violation of this part or an order or
- 26 interim order issued under this part, the person\_INDIVIDUAL is
- 27 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for

- 1 not less than 10 days or more than 180 days, and a fine of not less
- 2 than \$500.00 or more than \$2,000.00, and costs of prosecution.
