by amending section 18 (MCL 124.768); and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18. (1) The land bank fast track fund is created under
- 2 the jurisdiction and control of the state authority DEPARTMENT OF
- 3 TALENT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT and may be administered to secure
- 4 any notes and bonds of the state authority. DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS
- 5 ACT.

- (2) The state authority DEPARTMENT OF TALENT AND ECONOMIC
- DEVELOPMENT may receive money or other assets from any source for
- deposit into the fund. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ALL MONEY
- IN THE URBAN LAND ASSEMBLY LOAN FUND CREATED UNDER FORMER 1981 PA
- 171 TO THE FUND, AND CLOSE THE URBAN LAND ASSEMBLY LOAN FUND. ANY

- 1 LOAN REPAYMENTS THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE MADE TO THE URBAN LAND
- 2 ASSEMBLY LOAN FUND SHALL BE MADE TO THE FUND.

- 4 DEVELOPMENT shall credit to the fund interest and earnings from

- 16 (6) (5) The state authority DEPARTMENT OF TALENT AND ECONOMIC
- 17 DEVELOPMENT shall deposit into the fund all money it receives from
- 18 the sale or transfer of property under this act, subject to section
- 19 8. The state authority DEPARTMENT OF TALENT AND ECONOMIC
- 20 DEVELOPMENT shall credit to the fund the proceeds of the sale of
- 21 notes or bonds to the extent provided for in the authorizing
- 22 resolution of the DEPARTMENT OR THE FORMER state authority, and any
- 23 other money made available to the state authority DEPARTMENT for
- 24 the purposes of the fund.

- 26 PA 171, MCL 125.1851 to 125.1861, is repealed.
