- 1 SEC. 5506A. (1) AN APPLICATION FOR A NEW OR RENEWAL PERMIT
- 2 UNDER THIS PART AND A PERMIT FOR WHICH AN APPLICATION WAS FILED ON
- 3 OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A PLAN
- 4 FOR THE APPROPRIATE REDUCTION OF EMISSIONS TO PROTECT AIR QUALITY
- 5 ON WINTER THERMAL INVERSION ACTION DAYS DECLARED UNDER SECTION 5543
- 6 FOR THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA WHERE THE EMISSIONS SOURCE IS LOCATED. WHEN
- 7 A WINTER THERMAL INVERSION ACTION DAY IS DECLARED FOR THE
- 8 GEOGRAPHIC AREA WHERE THE EMISSIONS SOURCE IS LOCATED. THE
- 9 PERMITTEE SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PLAN AND PROMPTLY REPORT TO THE
