

HOUSE BILL No. 5338

February 10, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Vaupel, Barrett, Kosowski and Lucido and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 39, entitled
"Veteran right to employment services act,"
by amending section 2 (MCL 35.1092).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2 ~~—— (a) "Armed forces" means the army, air force, navy, marine~~
3 ~~corps, coast guard, or other military force designated by congress~~
4 ~~as a part of the armed forces of the United States.~~

5 (A) ~~(b)~~ "Employment services" means referrals to employers,
6 supportive services, or assistance in finding employment training.

7 (B) ~~(c)~~ "Job training services" means any program that
8 provides training or training services to eligible applicants.

9 (C) ~~(d)~~ "Veteran" means ~~any of the following:~~

10 ~~—— (i) A person who served on active duty in the armed forces for~~
11 ~~a period of more than 180 days and separated from the armed forces~~

1 ~~in a manner other than a dishonorable discharge.~~

2 ~~—— (ii) A person discharged or released from active duty because~~
3 ~~of a service related disability.~~

4 ~~—— (iii) A member of a reserve branch of the armed forces at the~~
5 ~~time he or she was ordered to active duty pursuant to section~~
6 ~~672(a), (d), or (g), or section 673 or 673b of title 10 of the~~
7 ~~United States Code, 10 U.S.C. 672, 673, and 673b, who served on~~
8 ~~active duty during a period of war, or in a campaign or expedition~~
9 ~~for which a campaign badge is authorized, and was released from~~

12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
13 after the date it is enacted into law.

14 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
15 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 5332 (request no.
16 02698'15 *) of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
